

Background

1. Aspirational Districts Programme (ADP)

Launched in 2018, the Aspirational Districts Programme (ADP) aims to quickly and effectively transform the most underdeveloped districts across India. The program covers 112 districts and focuses on 49 Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) under five broad socio-economic themes: Health & Nutrition, Education, Agriculture & Water Resources, Financial Inclusion, Skill Development, and Infrastructure. The initiative's objective is to uplift these districts by focusing on critical development areas and ensuring rapid improvement through targeted interventions.

Building on the success of the ADP, the Aspirational Blocks Programme (ABP) was launched in 2023 to address the development needs of underdeveloped blocks within districts. Covering 500 blocks across 329 districts, the ABP focuses on socio-economic indicators categorized under five major themes: Health and Nutrition, Education, Agriculture and Allied Services, Basic Infrastructure, and Social Development. The program aims to achieve substantial and sustainable development at the block level, thereby ensuring a more granular and effective approach to regional development.

3. Sampoornata Abhiyan as a Catalyst for Growth

The Sampoornata Abhiyan is a visionary initiative designed to drive rapid and tangible improvements in India's most underdeveloped regions. By focusing on six key indicators, the campaign seeks to deliver substantial impacts in health, nutrition, agriculture, and education, laying a strong foundation for long-term growth and development. The initiative will run from July 1, 2024, to September 30, 2024, and aims to achieve complete saturation of these indicators within the targeted districts and blocks.

Key Indicators for Sampoornata Abhiyan

- 1. Indicators for Aspirational Blocks Programme (ABP)
- a. Antenatal Care Registration: Increasing the percentage of pregnant women registered within the first trimester.
- b. Diabetes Screening: Enhancing the screening rate for diabetes among the targeted population.
- c. Hypertension Screening: Improving the screening rate for hypertension in the block.
- d. Supplementary Nutrition: Ensuring pregnant women receive regular nutrition under the Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) Programme.
- e. Soil Health Cards: Generating soil health cards against the collection target.
- f. Self-Help Groups: Providing revolving funds to a higher percentage of Self-Help Groups (SHGs).
- 2. Indicators for Aspirational Districts Programme (ADP)
- a. Antenatal Care Registration: Similar to the block-level focus.
- b. Supplementary Nutrition: Ensuring pregnant women receive regular nutrition.
- c. Child Immunization: Increasing the percentage of fully immunized children (9-11 months).
- d. Soil Health Cards: Distributing soil health cards to farmers.
- e. School Electrification: Ensuring functional electricity in secondary schools.
- f. Timely Textbook Distribution: Providing textbooks to children within one month of the academic session's start.


