







Basic English Words- Categories and Examples

Basic English words can be categorized into several groups based on their functions and roles in the language. Here are some categories of most common words in English:

• Nouns: Nouns are words that represent people, places, things, or ideas.

Common Nouns: Tree, Car, Friend, Movie, Time, Money, Family, Job, School, Food

Verbs: Verbs are action words that describe what someone or something is doing.

Common Verbs: Go, See, Speak, Listen, Want, Need, Work, Play, Help, Understand

 Adjectives: Adjectives are words that describe or modify nouns. They provide more information about a noun's characteristics.

Common Adjectives: Happy, Sad, Big, Small, Hot, Cold, New, Old, Beautiful, Ugly

• Adverbs: Adverbs modify verbs, adjectives, or other adverbs and provide information about how, when, where, or to what degree an action is performed.

Common Adverbs: Now, Always, Often, Here, There, Very, Well, Fast, Slowly, Never

• **Pronouns:** Pronouns are words used to replace nouns in order to avoid repetition.

Common Pronouns: She, They, It, We, You, Myself, Him, Hers, Ours, Whose

Conjunctions: Conjunctions are words that connect words, phrases, or clauses.

Common Conjunctions: Because, Since, While, However, Therefore, Although, Even, Or, Nor, But

• **Prepositions:** Prepositions are words that show the relationship between a noun or pronoun and other words in a sentence. They indicate location, direction, time, or manner.

Common Prepositions: Of, By, With, On, In, At, For, Over, Under, Between

- Articles: Articles are used to indicate whether a noun is specific or nonspecific. English has these articles: "the" (definite article) and "a" or "an" (indefinite articles).
- **Determiners:** Determiners are words that introduce or specify nouns.

Common Determiners: This, Some, Many, Few, Each, Every, Both, All, Any, Several

• Interjections: Interjections are words or phrases used to express strong emotions, often appearing in exclamatory sentences.


