· Work: To engage in an activity for pay or as a duty.

Example: "I work at a software company."

4. Time Expressions

· Now: At the present time.

Example: "I am busy right now."

· Today: The current day.

• Tomorrow: The day following today.

Example: "I have a meeting tomorrow."

5. Describing People

• Happy: Feeling or showing pleasure.

Example: "She looks so happy today."

• Tired: In need of rest or sleep.

Example: "I'm too tired to go out."

• Friendly: Kind and pleasant.

Example: "My neighbor is very friendly."

6. Other English words for daily use

• Nouns: Examples include "friend," "family," "home," "job," and "food."

Usage in sentence: I would be spending time with my family this weekend.

· Verbs: Common verbs include "eat," "work," "talk," "listen," and "play."

Usage in sentence: You should eat healthy food.

· Adjectives: "Happy," "sad," "big," "small," "hot," and "cold."

Usage in sentence: She felt sad when she came to know about his loss.

· Adverbs: Examples include "quickly," "always," "very," and "here."

Usage in sentence: I submitted my work very late.

• Pronouns: Common pronouns include "I," "you," "he," "she," "it," and "they."

Usage in sentence: They often visit this place.

· Conjunctions: "And," "but," "because," and "although."

Usage in sentence: I submitted my work very late but I became regular after that.

• Prepositions: Common prepositions include "in," "on," "at," "with," and "between."

Usage in sentence: Your wallet is on the table.




Everyday English - Essential English Words for Daily Use
