**Synonyms of Jumble:** Muddle, Confusion, Mess, Chaos, Disorder

### Meanings of the other options

**Assortment:** a miscellaneous collection of things or people.

**Muddle:** bring into a disordered or confusing state.

**Chaos:** complete disorder and confusion.

**Joggle:** move or cause to move with repeated small bobs or jerks.

**Q:3** The antonym of **Juxtapose** is **Juxtapose** i.e., **Option 4**.

**Juxtapose Meaning:** place or deal with close together for contrasting effect.

**How to use Juxtapose in a sentence:** In the art gallery, the curator decided to juxtapose classical paintings with modern sculptures to create a thought-provoking contrast for the visitors.

**Detached Meaning:** separate or disconnected.

**How to use Detached in a sentence:** She maintained a detached demeanour during the heated argument, choosing to stay calm and impartial.

**Synonyms of Juxtapose:** Compare, Contrast, Collate, Place side by side, Pair

### Meanings of the other options

**Adjacent:** lying next or near.

**Colligate:** be or cause to be juxtaposed or grouped in a syntactic relation.

**Collocate:** be habitually juxtaposed with another with a frequency greater than chance.

**Q:4** The antonym of **Jug** is **Unconfined** i.e., **Option 3**.

**Jug Meaning:** prosecute and imprison (someone).

**How to use Jug in a sentence:** She poured the freshly squeezed orange juice from the jug into a glass, filling it to the brim with the refreshing drink.

**Unconfined Meaning:** not confined to a limited space.

**How to use Unconfined in a sentence:** The vast desert stretched out before them, unconfined by any visible borders, and it seemed to go on endlessly in all directions.

**Synonyms of Jug:** Pitcher, Jar, Vessel, Container, Decanter+

### Meanings of the other options

**Prosecute:** continue with (a course of action) with a view to its completion.

**Imprison:** put or keep in prison or a place like a prison.

**Penitentiary:** a prison for people convicted of serious crimes.

**Q:5** The antonym of **Jubilation** is **Despondency** i.e., **Option 2.**

**Jubilation Meaning:** a feeling of great happiness and triumph.

**How to use Jubilation in a sentence:** The crowd erupted in jubilation as their team scored the winning goal in the final moments of the championship match, securing their victory and sparking a city-wide celebration.

**Despondency Meaning:** low spirits from loss of hope or courage; dejection.

**How to use Despondency in a sentence:** His prolonged unemployment and financial struggles led to a deep sense of despondency, causing him to lose hope for a better future.

**Synonyms of Jubilation:** Celebration, Rejoicing, Elation, Exultation, Triumph

### Meanings of the other options

**Glee:** great delight, especially from one's own good fortune or another's misfortune.

**Jubilance:** what you feel when you're happy, joyful, or triumphant.

**Cheerfulness:** the quality or state of being noticeably happy and optimistic.

**Q:6** The synonym of **Jockey** is **Jostle** i.e., **Option 4.**

**Jockey:** struggle by every available means to gain or achieve something.

**How to use Jockey in a sentence:** The experienced jockey skillfully guided his horse through the challenging course, maintaining a strong lead to win the race.

**Jostle:** push, elbow, or bump against (someone) roughly, typically in a crowd.

**Applauses Meaning:** approval shown especially by clapping the hands.

**How to use Applauses in a sentence:** The actor received thunderous applauses from the audience after delivering an exceptional performance on opening night.

**Antonyms of Jeer:** Applaud, Praise, Encourage, Compliment, Support

### Meanings of the other options

**Snorts:** an explosive sound made by the sudden forcing of breath through one's nose, used to express indignation, derision, or incredulity.

**Sneers:** a contemptuous or mocking smile, remark, or tone.

**Hisses:** make a sharp sibilant sound as of the letter s.

**Q:8** The synonym of **Juncture** is **Predicament** i.e., **Option 1**.

**Juncture Meaning:** a particular point in events or time.

**How to use Juncture in a sentence:** The meeting at this crucial juncture in our project will determine the direction we take for the next phase of development.

**Serious:** demanding or characterized by careful consideration or application.
