Q:1 The correct answer is option 2 i.e. Extrinsic

Kindred Meaning: similar in kind; related.

How to use Kindred in a sentence: Even though they were born in different countries, their shared love for art and culture made them kindred spirits, and they quickly became lifelong friends.

Extrinsic Meaning: not part of the essential nature of someone or something; coming or operating from outside.

How to use Extrinsic in a sentence: The company's success was partly due to the extrinsic factors of a booming economy and favorable government policies that created a conducive business environment.

Synonyms of Kindred: Similar, Akin, Related, Affiliated, Allied

Meanings of the other options

Analogue: something that is similar to something else.

Cognate: related; connected.

Affiliated: officially attached or connected to an organization.

Q:2 The correct answer is option 1 i.e. Awake

Kip Meaning: to sleep

How to use Kip in a sentence: After a long day of hiking, he decided to take a quick kip under the shade of a tree to recharge before continuing his journey.

Awake Meaning: stop sleeping; wake from sleep.

How to use Awake in a sentence: I couldn't fall asleep last night, so I lay awake in bed, tossing and turning, until the early hours of the morning.

Synonyms of Kip: Sleep, Nap, Slumber, Rest, Snooze

Meanings of the other options

Sack out: to go to bed; go to sleep.

Drop off: a very steep or perpendicular descent.

Doss: sleep in rough accommodation or on an improvised bed.

Q:3 The correct answer is **option 4** i.e. **Jibe**

Kowtow Meaning: act in an excessively subservient manner.

How to use Kowtow in a sentence: Despite her strong principles, she felt pressured to kowtow to her boss's demands in order to keep her job.

Jibe Meaning: an insulting or mocking remark; a taunt.

How to use Jibe in a sentence: His comments about the project not meeting its deadlines didn't jibe with the actual progress we've made, as we are ahead of schedule.

Synonyms of Kowtow: Grovel, Fawn, Flatter, Prostrate, Brownnose

Meanings of the other options

Grovel: lie or crawl abjectly on the ground with one's face downwards.

Truckle: a small barrel-shaped cheese, especially Cheddar.

Blandish: coax (someone) with kind words or flattery.

Q:4 The correct answer is **option 3** i.e. **Top-notch**

Kitsch Meaning: considered to be in poor taste but appreciated in an ironic or knowing way

How to use Kitsch in a sentence: The hotel's lobby was filled with an overwhelming amount of kitsch, from the neon lights to the plastic decorations, making it feel more like a carnival than a place of relaxation.

Top-notch Meaning: of the highest quality; excellent.

How to use Top-notch in a sentence: The top-notch service and exquisite cuisine at the restaurant left us thoroughly impressed and eager to return for another dining experience.

Synonyms of Kitsch: Tackiness, Vulgarly, Gaudiness, Tastelessness, Tawdriness

Meanings of the other options

Tawdry: showy but cheap and of poor quality.

Gimcrack: showy but cheap or badly made.

Gaudy: extravagantly bright or showy, typically so as to be tasteless.

Kaput Meaning: broken and useless; no longer working or effective.

How to use Kaput in a sentence: After years of faithful service, the old car finally gave up and was declared kaput by the mechanic.

Preserved Meaning: maintain (something) in its original or existing state.

How to use Preserved in a sentence: The ancient manuscript, meticulously preserved in a climate-controlled archive, held the secrets of a long-lost civilization.

Synonyms of Kaput: Broken, Ruined, Nonfunctional, Defunct, Inoperable

Meanings of the other options

Broken: having been broken.

Destroyed: having been broken.

Devastated: very shocked and upset.

Q:6 The correct answer is **option 2** i.e. **Cachet**

Kudos Meaning: praise and honour received for an achievement.

How to use Kudos in a sentence: She received kudos from her colleagues for her outstanding performance on the project, which contributed significantly to its success.

Cachet Meaning: the state of being respected or admired; prestige.

How to use Cachet in a sentence: Her impressive collection of vintage designer handbags lent a certain cachet to her fashion sense, making her the envy of her friends.

Antonyms of Kudos: Blame, Disapproval, Criticism, Censure, Denunciation

Meanings of the other options

Obscurity: the state of being unknown, inconspicuous, or unimportant.

Infamy: the state of being well known for some bad quality or deed.

Insignificant: too small or unimportant to be worth consideration.

Q:7 The correct answer is **option 4** i.e. **Civilian**

Knight Meaning: (in the Middle Ages) a man who served his sovereign or lord as a mounted soldier in armour.

How to use Knight in a sentence: Knight in a sentence:

Chevalier Meaning: a member of certain orders of knighthood or of modern French orders such as the Legion of Honour.

How to use Chevalier in a sentence: He was awarded the title of Chevalier for his exceptional contributions to the arts, a well-deserved honor for his lifetime of artistic achievement.

Antonyms of Knight: Peasant, Commoner, Serf, Villager, Laborer

Meanings of the other options

Antagonist: a person who actively opposes or is hostile to someone or something; an adversary.

Adversary: an enemy or opponent

Civilian: a person not in the armed services or the police force.

Q:8 The correct answer is **option 4** i.e. **Pilferer**

Kleptomania Meaning: a recurrent urge to steal, typically without regard for need or profit.

How to use Kleptomania in a sentence: Kleptomania is a mental disorder characterized by an irresistible urge to steal items, often with no personal gain or necessity.

Pilferer Meaning: a person who steals things of little value or in small quantities, especially from the place where they work.

How to use Pilferer in a sentence: The pilferer stealthily entered the room and pocketed a few valuable items before slipping away unnoticed.

Antonyms of Kleptomania: Honesty, Integrity, Morality, Uprightness, Virtue

Meanings of the other options

Contributor: a person or thing that contributes something.

Police: (of a police force) have the duty of maintaining law and order in or at (an area or event).

Investigator: a person who carries out a formal inquiry or investigation.

Kinship Meaning: a sharing of characteristics or origins.

How to use Kinship in a sentence: Despite their different backgrounds, they discovered a kinship in their shared love for art and music.

Kindred Meaning: one's family and relations.

How to use Kindred in a sentence: She felt a deep kindred connection with her grandmother, as if they shared a special bond that transcended generations.

Antonyms of Kinship: Estrangement, Disconnection, Alienation, Discord, Dissociation

Meanings of the other options

Variance: the fact or quality of being different, divergent, or inconsistent.

Disaffiliation: the act of ending the link between a group, a company or an organization and a larger one.

Affinity: a natural liking for and understanding of someone or something.

Kinesis Meaning: movement; motion.

How to use Kinesis in a sentence: The study of animal kinesis involves observing and analyzing the various forms of movement and behavior exhibited by different species in response to environmental stimuli.

Energetic Meaning: showing or involving great activity or vitality.

How to use Energetic in a sentence: He's always so energetic in the morning, ready to tackle the day with enthusiasm and a positive attitude.

Antonyms of Kinesis: Stasis, Rest, Inactivity, Stillness, Immobility

Meanings of the other options

Languid: weak or faint from illness or fatigue.

Vapid: offering nothing that is stimulating or challenging; bland.

Tedious: too long, slow, or dull; tiresome or monotonous.
