**Mend:** repair (something that is broken or damaged).

**Rehabilitate:** restore (someone) to health or normal life by training and therapy after imprisonment, addiction, or illness.

**Incapacitate:** prevent from functioning in a normal way.

**Crisp:** (of a substance) firm, dry, and brittle.

**Brusque:** markedly short and abrupt.

**Maul Meaning:** (of an animal) wound (a person or animal) by scratching and tearing.

**How to use Maul in a sentence:** The enraged bear mauled the hiker when it felt threatened, causing severe injuries that required immediate medical attention.

**Savage Meaning :** (of an animal or force of nature) fierce, violent, and uncontrolled.

**How to use Savage in a sentence:** The wild and savage landscape of the desert presented both beauty and danger to those who dared to explore its unforgiving terrain.

**Synonyms of Maul:** Mangle, Attack, Injure, Damage, Tear

### Meanings of the other options

**Surrender:** stop resisting an enemy or opponent and submit to their authority.
