Meanings of the other options

Disjunction: a lack of correspondence or consistency.

Antonyms of Neurotic: Calm, Serene, Composed, Relaxed, Unperturbed

Meanings of the other options

Discerning: having or showing good judgement.

Coherent: logical and consistent.

Symmetrical: made up of exactly similar parts facing each other or around an axis; showing symmetry.

Nether Meaning: lower in position.

Blench: make a sudden flinching movement out of fear or pain.

Synonyms of Nefarious: Villainous, Wicked, Evil, Malevolent, Sinister

Meanings of the other options

Atrocious: horrifyingly wicked.

Despicable: deserving hatred and contempt.

Egregious: outstandingly bad; shocking.

Necromancy Meaning: a form of magic or divination in which a person communicates with the dead.

Synonyms of Necromancy: Sorcery, Witchcraft, Magic, Divination, Enchantment

Meanings of the other options

Wizardry: the art or practice of magic.

Witchcraft: the practice of magic, especially for evil purposes; the use of spells.

Sorcery: the use of magic, especially black magic.

Necessitate Meaning: make (something) necessary as a result or consequence.

Synonyms of Necessitate: Require, Demand, Compel, Oblige, Enforce

Meanings of the other options

Entail: involve (something) as a necessary or inevitable part or consequence.

Synonyms of Nautical: Maritime, Naval, Marine, Seafaring, Oceanic

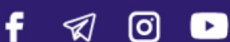
