**Leisure:** the time when one is not working or occupied; free time.

**Pansophical Meaning:** universal wisdom or encyclopedic knowledge

**How to use Pansophical in a sentence:** The professor was renowned for his pansophical knowledge, having expertise in a wide range of subjects and fields of study.

**Antonyms of Omniscient:** Ignorant, Uninformed, Clueless, Unaware, Oblivious

### Meanings of the other options

**Mortal:** subject to death.

**Unknowing:** not knowing or aware.

**Earthly:** relating to the earth or human life.

**Omen Meaning:** a happening believed to be a sign or warning of some future event.

**Unconcern:** a lack of worry or interest, especially when surprising or callous.

**Disesteem:** low esteem or regard.

**Antonyms of ogle:** Ignore, Look away, Neglect, Overlook.

### Meanings of the other options

**Overlook:** fail to notice.

**Ignore:** refuse to take notice of or acknowledge; disregard intentionally.

**Neglect:** fail to care for properly.

**Q:6** The antonym of **Obstruct** is **Comprehensible** i.e. **option 2**.

**Obstruct Meaning:** block (an opening, path, road, etc.); be or get in the way of.

**How to use Obstruct in a sentence:** A large tree obstructed the road.

**Comprehensible Meaning:** able to be understood; intelligible.

**How to use Comprehensible in a sentence:** Her speech was slurred and barely comprehensible.

**Synonyms of Obstruct:** Occlude, Clog, Barricade, Block up, Gum up

### Meanings of the other options

**Occlude:** stop, close up, or obstruct (an opening, orifice, or passage).

**Clog:** a shoe with a thick wooden sole.

**Barricade:** an improvised barrier erected across a street or other thoroughfare to prevent or delay the movement of opposing forces.

**Obtuse Meaning:** annoyingly insensitive or slow to understand.

**Synonyms of Obtuse:** Witless, Imperceptive, Stolid, Vacuous, Clueless

**Meanings of the other options**

**Witless:** foolish; stupid.

**Imperceptive:** lacking in perception or insight.

**Stolid:** calm, dependable, and showing little emotion or animation.

**Q:8** The antonym of **Obsequious** is **Domineering** i.e. **option 1**.

**Obsequious Meaning:** obedient or attentive to an excessive or servile degree.

**How to use Obsequious in a sentence:** The obsequious waiter fawned over the wealthy patron, offering compliments and excessive attention in hopes of receiving a generous tip.

**Domineering Meaning:** asserting one's will over another in an arrogant way.

**How to use Domineering in a sentence:** The manager's domineering leadership style left little room for input from team members, as he insisted on making all decisions without considering their perspectives.

**Synonyms of Obsequious:** Servile, Fawning, Sycophantic, Groveling, Submissive

**Servile:** having or showing an excessive willingness to serve or please others.

**Unctuous:** excessively flattering or ingratiating; oily.

**Sycophantic:** behaving or done in an obsequious way in order to gain advantage.

**Obloquy Meaning:** strong public condemnation.

**Honour Meaning:** high respect; great esteem.

**How to use Honour in a sentence:** She was awarded the highest honour in her field for her groundbreaking research on renewable energy.

**Synonyms of Obloquy:** Censure, Discredit, Infamy, Scandal, Shame

**Meanings of the other options**

**Vilification:** abusively disparaging speech or writing.

**Opprobrium:** harsh criticism or censure.

**Vituperation:** bitter and abusive language.

**Honour:** high respect; great esteem.

**Q:10** The antonym of **Oblivious** is **Conscious** i.e., **option 3**.

**Oblivious Meaning:** not aware of or concerned about what is happening around one.
