Lax: not sufficiently strict, severe, or careful.

Antonyms of Paradox: Clarity, Simplicity, Certainty, Consistency, Straightforwardness

Standard: something set up or established by an authority as a rule for the measure of quantity, weight, extent, value, or quality.

Accuracy: free from mistake or error.
