Revive Meaning: Restore to life or consciousness; give new strength or energy to.

Comatose Meaning: In a state of deep unconsciousness for a prolonged period.

How to use Pragmatic in a sentence: She took a pragmatic approach to solving the complex issue.

Synonyms of Quixotic: Idealistic, Romantic, Unrealistic, Visionary, Impractical.

Meaning of other words in options:

Idealistic Meaning: Characterized by idealism; unrealistically aiming for perfection.

Realistic Meaning: Having a sensible and practical view of situations and problems; concerned with facts and reality.

Rational Meaning: Based on or in accordance with reason or logic.

Q:7 The antonym of **Quizzical** is **Serious**, i.e. Option 3.

Quizzical Meaning: perplexed (as if being expected to know something that you do not know); mild or amused puzzlement.

How to use Quizzical in a sentence: She raised a quizzical eyebrow in response to his strange question.

Serious Meaning: Grave in manner or disposition; not playful or trifling.

How to use Serious in a sentence: The situation demanded a serious discussion among the team members.

Synonyms of Quizzical: Puzzled, Baffled, Inquisitive, Curious, Skeptical.

Meaning of other words in options:

Puzzled Meaning: Confused, uncertain, or unable to understand.

Baffled Meaning: Totally bewildered or perplexed; unable to comprehend.

Inquisitive Meaning: Eager to learn or know; curious.

Q:8 The antonym of **Quandary** is **Certainty**, i.e. Option 1.

Quandary Meaning: A state of uncertainty or confusion over what to do in a difficult situation.

How to use Quandary in a sentence: She was in a quandary about whether to accept the job offer.

Certainty Meaning: A firm conviction that something is the case; sureness.

Dilemma Meaning: State of uncertainty or perplexity especially as requiring a choice between equally unfavorable options

Predicament Meaning: A difficult, unpleasant, or embarrassing situation.

Confusion Meaning: Lack of clarity; state of being mixed up or puzzled.

Quench Meaning: To put out, put an end to, or Satisfy (one's thirst);

How to use Quench in a sentence: The cold water helped quench his thirst after the workout.
