Solutions for V words

Q:1 The synonym of **valiant** is **Brave** i.e. **option 2**.

Valiant Meaning: Showing bravery and determination in the face of danger or difficulty.

How to use Valiant in a sentence: Despite facing overwhelming odds, the valiant soldiers fought bravely to defend their homeland from the invading enemy.

Brave Meaning: Ready to face danger or pain; showing courage.

How to use Brave in a sentence: Even though she was terrified of heights, she summoned her courage and took a brave step onto the narrow suspension bridge, determined to conquer her fear.

Antonyms of Valiant: Cowardly, Timid, Fearful, Weak, Craven

Meanings of the other options

Cowardly: Lacking in courage or bravery.

Timid: Showing a lack of courage or confidence; easily frightened.

Inept: Lacking skill or ability.

Q:2 The synonym of **Valedictory** is **Farewell** i.e. **option 1**.

Valedictory Meaning: relating to or expressing farewell, especially as a speech or address.

How to use Valedictory in a sentence: At the graduation ceremony, the valedictory speech was delivered by the top student in the class, who reflected on the years of hard work and shared inspiring words for the future.

Antonyms of Valedictory: Welcome, Greeting, Introduction, Inaugural, Opening

Meanings of the other options

Welcome: an expression of greeting or reception

Congratulate: express warm approval or admiration of someone's achievement or good wishes on a special occasion

Commemoration: the act of remembering and showing respect for someone or something through a ceremony or event

Q:3 The synonym of **Vainglorious** is **Arrogant** i.e. **option 4**.

Vainglorious Meaning: excessively proud and boastful, especially about one's achievements or possessions.

How to use Vainglorious in a sentence:

The vainglorious actor couldn't resist boasting about his minor role in the film, exaggerating his contribution to the production.

Arrogant Meaning: having or showing a high opinion of oneself and a low opinion of others; supercilious.

How to use Arrogant in a sentence:

His arrogant demeanor and condescending remarks made it difficult for anyone to enjoy his company at the party.

Antonyms of vainglorious: Humble, Modest, Self-effacing, Unpretentious

Meanings of the other options:

Humble Meaning: having or showing a modest or low estimate of one's importance; unpretentious.

Modest Meaning: having or showing a moderate or humble estimate of one's merits, importance, etc.; free from vanity, egotism, boastfulness, or great pretensions.

Selfless Meaning: having little or no concern for oneself, especially with regard to fame, position, money, etc.; unselfish.

Q:4 The synonym of **vain** is **conceited** i.e. **option 3**.

Vain Meaning: having or showing an excessively high opinion of one's appearance, abilities, or worth.

How to use vain in a sentence:

Despite her vain attempts to impress her colleagues with extravagant gifts, they valued her sincerity and hard work more than material gestures.

Conceited Meaning: having an excessively favorable opinion of oneself and one's abilities.

How to use conceited in a sentence:

His conceited attitude and constant bragging about his achievements alienated his friends, who grew tired of his self-centered behavior.

Antonyms of vain: Productive, Useful, Successful, Effective

Meaning of other words are:

Humble Meaning: having or showing a modest or low estimate of one's importance.

Modest Meaning: unassuming or moderate in the estimation of one's abilities or achievements.

Selfless Meaning: concerned more with the needs and wishes of others than with one's own; unselfish.

Q:5 The synonym of **vague** is **ambiguous** i.e. **option 2**.

Vague Meaning: not clearly or explicitly stated or expressed; indefinite or indistinct in nature or character.

How to use vague in a sentence:

Her instructions were so vague that nobody in the group could figure out what exactly needed to be done, leading to confusion and delays in the project.

Ambiguous Meaning: having more than one possible meaning or interpretation; unclear or indefinite in nature or character.

How to use ambiguous in a sentence:

The ambiguous statement from the politician left the audience unsure of his true intentions and led to a heated debate about his stance on the issue.

Antonyms of vague: Clear, Specific, Precise, Distinct

Meanings of the other options:

Specific Meaning: clearly defined or identified; precise or particular.

Clear Meaning: easy to perceive, understand, or interpret; not blurred or obscured.

Precise Meaning: marked by exactness and accuracy of expression or detail.

Q:6 The antonym of **vehement** is **mild** i.e. **option 2**.

Vehement Meaning: showing strong feeling; forceful, passionate, or intense.

How to use vehement in a sentence:

The protesters were vehement in their demands for justice, chanting slogans and marching through the streets with unwavering determination.

Mild Meaning: gentle and not harsh; not severe.

How to use mild in a sentence:

The curry had a mild flavor, making it suitable for those who preferred a less spicy and more subtle taste.

Synonyms of vehement: Passionate, Intense, Fervent, Energetic

Meaning of other options:

Passionate Meaning: showing strong emotions, especially about something that you believe in.

Intense Meaning: very strong; very great; very serious or extreme.

Forceful Meaning: done with force; strong and assertive; powerful.

Q:7 The antonym of **vegetate** is **bloom** i.e. **option 1**.

Vegetate Meaning: To lead a life that lacks mental or physical stimulation; to live in a dull or inactive state.

How to use vegetate in a sentence:

After a long week of work, all he wanted to do was vegetate on the couch, binge-watching his favorite TV shows and enjoying some much-needed relaxation.

Bloom Meaning: To produce flowers; to mature or develop to the fullest extent.

How to use bloom in a sentence:

In the spring, the garden burst into vibrant colors as the flowers began to bloom, creating a picturesque scene of natural beauty.

Synonyms of vegetate: Languish, Idle, Stagnate, Lounge

Meaning of other words

Flourish Meaning: To thrive or prosper; to grow luxuriantly or in abundance.

Sprout Meaning: To begin to grow or develop; to emerge from the ground as a young plant.

Wither Meaning: To shrivel or dry up; to lose vitality or freshness.

Q:8 The antonym of **vaunt** is **conceal** i.e. **option 4**.

Vaunt Meaning: to boast or brag about one's abilities or achievements.

How to use vaunt in a sentence:

He couldn't resist the urge to vaunt his new sports car to his friends, showing off its sleek design and powerful engine at every opportunity.

Conceal Meaning: to hide or keep secret.

How to use conceal in a sentence:

She tried to conceal her excitement, but her eyes sparkled with joy as she unwrapped the surprise gift.

Synonyms of vaunt: Boast, Brag, Show off, Parade

Meaning of other options:

Boast Meaning: to speak with pride and self-satisfaction about one's achievements, possessions, or abilities.

Hide Meaning: to put or keep out of sight.

Flaunt Meaning: to display something ostentatiously or defiantly, especially in order to provoke envy or admiration.

Q:9 The antonym of **vassal** is **sovereign** i.e. **option 3**.

Vassal Meaning: A person who owes loyalty to a superior and is bound to protect and serve them in exchange for land or other benefits.

How to use vassal in a sentence:

In the feudal system, the lord granted land to his loyal vassal in exchange for the vassal's service and loyalty, creating a hierarchical relationship between them.

Sovereign Meaning: A supreme ruler, usually a king or queen, who has authority over a territory and its people.

How to use **sovereign** in a sentence:

The sovereign ruler of the kingdom made important decisions that affected the lives of all the citizens in the realm.

Synonyms of vassal: Subject, Serf, Fiefholder, Liegeman

Meaning of other options:

Master Meaning: A person who has control or authority over others, often in a professional or vocational context.

Servant Meaning: A person who performs duties or services for others, especially in a household or as an employee.

Lord Meaning: A person who has power, authority, or control over others, often in a feudal context.

Q:10 The antonym of **variegated** is **Homogeneous** i.e., **option 2**.

Variegated Meaning: having various colors, forms, or patterns.

How to used **variegated** in a sentence:

The variegated leaves of the tropical plant added a burst of color to the otherwise green and lush garden.

Homogeneous Meaning: consisting of the same kind or nature; uniform in structure or composition.

How to used **homogeneous** in a sentence:

The research team needed a homogeneous sample of the material to ensure consistent test results across all experiments.

Synonyms of variegated: Multicolored, Diverse, Motley, Heterogeneous

Meaning of other words:

Monochromatic Meaning: consisting of or displaying only one color or hue.

Uniform Meaning: always the same in form, manner, or degree; without variation or difference.

Consistent Meaning: in agreement or harmony; compatible.
