## Solutions of Filler Questions

**Q:1 The correct answer is option 4 i.e. For.**

When we talk about a time span in a sentence, there are two prepositions that mainly occur and they are 'for' and 'since'.

for is used to denote a time period.

since is used to denote the beginning of time.

That is why, for suits best in this sentence.

Hence, option 4 is correct.

**Q:2 The correct answer is option 2 i.e. Would.**

The given sentence is an example of Indirect speech.

In indirect speech, 'can' and 'will' are generally not used.

Had to is making the sentence grammatically incorrect.

Hence, option 2 is correct.

**Q:3 The correct answer is option 2 i.e. Expecting.**

Upon reading the sentence, we can infer that the person had created the mess in the place because he thought that no one would arrive in there.

That is why 'expecting' is the correct filler.

Meaning of 'Get away' is departed.
