Solutions of Voice Questions

Q:1 The correct answer is Option 4 i.e. **A new amusement park is being built in this city by our government.**

The structure of the given **Active voice** sentence is **Subject + v2 + object + other words.**

The structure of the given **Passive voice** sentence is **Object + was/were + v3 + by + subject + other words.**

V2 i.e. took will be converted into V3 i.e., **taken.**

'by' will be used just before the subject in the passive sentence.

Thus, the most appropriate form of a passive sentence is:

A new amusement park is being built in this city by our government.

Q:2 The correct answer is **Option 2** i.e. **Some important documents are being prepared for the presentation by my father.**

The structure of the given **Active voice** sentence is **Subject + v2 + object + other words.**

The structure of the given **Passive voice** sentence is **Object + was/were + v3 + by + subject + other words.**

V2 i.e. took will be converted into V3 i.e., **taken.**

'by' will be used just before the subject in the passive sentence.

Thus, the most appropriate form of a passive sentence is:

Some important documents are being prepared for the presentation by my father.

Q:3 The correct answer is **option 3** i.e. **Nobody is trusted by him.**

To convert the given sentence into its passive form, the following rules are followed:

Identify the subject and object of the active sentence:

Subject: He

Object: anybody

Make the object of the active sentence the subject of the passive sentence:

Object 'anybody' becomes the subject 'Nobody.'

Change the verb 'trust' into its passive form 'is trusted.'

The subject 'He' of the active sentence becomes 'by him' in the passive sentence to indicate the doer of the action.

Include the appropriate auxiliary verb 'is' to create the passive construction.

Q:4 The correct answer is **option 3** i.e. **The work will have been finished by Sheetal.**

Given sentence: Sheetal will have finished the work. (Active voice)

The given sentence is in the future perfect tense.

Structure of active voice: Subject + will + have + V3 + Object

Structure of passive voice: Object + will + have + been + V3 + Subject

Sentence in passive voice: The work will have been finished by Sheetal.

Q:5 The correct answer is **option 3** i.e. **Medicines should not be bought without the doctor's prescription.**

Basic rules to be followed for Active/Passive conversions are:

1. The object of the active verb becomes the subject of the passive verb.
2. Only 3rd form of the verb will be used as a main verb in the Passive Voice.

The given sentence is in active voice.

Important Points to Ponder:

The sentence is a suggestion.

It is suggesting that we should not buy medicine without the doctor's prescription.

'Need' is a semi-modal verb and we use need mostly in the negative form to indicate that there is no obligation or necessity to do something.

The sentence is not talking about obligations. Similarly, 'might' and 'could' do not show the intended meaning of the sentence and are the wrong modal verbs for this context.

Q:6 The correct answer is **option 2** i.e. **A ban on spitting in public has been introduced by the Indian government.**

Active voice - Subject + has/have + V3 + object + other words.

Passive voice- Object + has/have + been + v3 + subject + other words.

Q:7 The correct answer is option 1 i.e. **The dearness allowance policy has not been approved by the government for its employee.**

The given sentence is in **active voice** and in it is in the Present Perfect Tense. We need to change it into **passive voice**.

General Rule:-

Active voice- Subject + has/have + not + past participle + object + other words.

Passive voice- Object + has/have + not been + past participle + by + subject + other words.

The **subject** and **object** of the active voice become **object** and **subject** in the passive voice respectively.

Q:8 The correct answer is **option 3** i.e. **We are reading it.**

Given sentence: It is being read by us. (Passive voice)

The given sentence is in the perfect continuous tense.

Structure of passive voice: Object + is/am/are + being + V3 + Subject

Structure of active voice: Subject + is/am/are + V1 + ing + Object

Sentence in active voice: We are reading it.

Q:9 The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. **A car is being bought by Daniel.**

Given sentence: Daniel is buying a car. (Active voice)

Structure of active voice: Subject + is/are/am/was/were + ing form of Verb + Object

Structure of passive voice: Object + is/are/am/was/were + being + V3 + by + Subject

Sentence in passive voice: A car is being bought by Daniel.

Q:10 The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. **The stag was being chased by the lion behind the bush.**

Given sentence: The lion was chasing the stag behind the bush. (Active voice)

The given sentence is in the past continuous tense.

Structure of active voice: Subject + was/were + ing form of verb + Object

Structure of passive voice: Object + was/were + being + V3 + by + Subject

Sentence in passive voice: The stag was being chased by the lion behind the bush.
