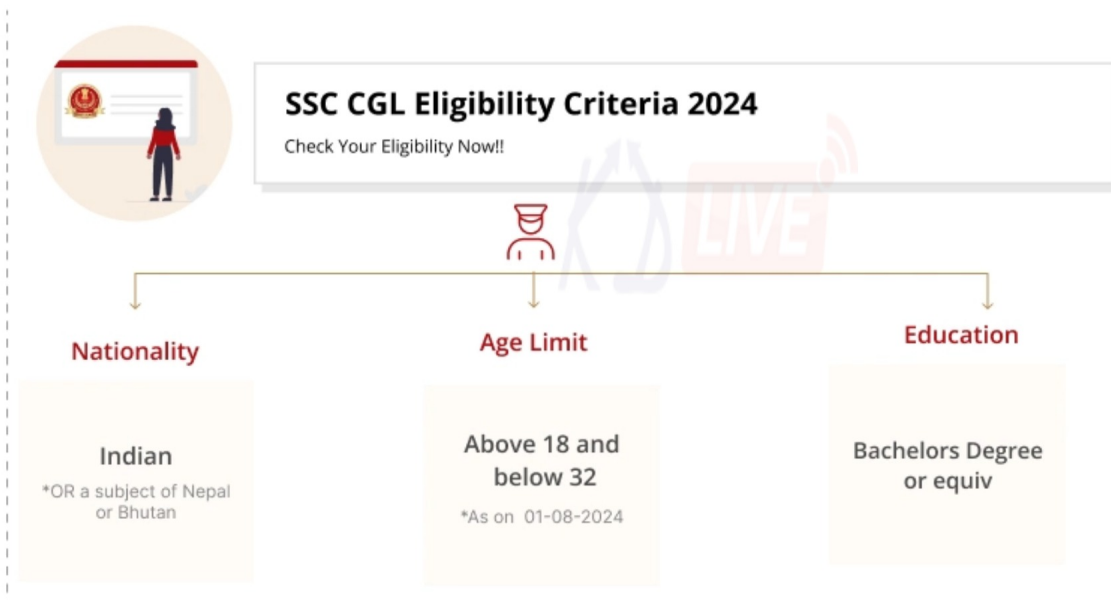


Eligibility of SSC CGL - Age, Education

Nationality

The first SSC CGL Eligibility Criteria pertains to nationality. To meet the eligibility of SSC CGL exam, you must fall into one of the following categories:

- Be an Indian citizen.
- Be a citizen of Nepal.
- Be a citizen of Bhutan.
- Be a person of Indian origin who has relocated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, the East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania, Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia, or Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India.

Eligibility of SSC CGL - Age, Education

Age

According to the SSC CGL Eligibility Criteria, you, as a candidate, can complete the application form if you fall within the age bracket of 18 to 32 years. Refer to the table below to learn about the various posts and their corresponding age requirements. Keep in mind that these details are based on the SSC CGL Notification 2023, as the 2024 notification is yet to be released. This information is crucial for understanding the eligibility of SSC CGL.

S No	Age Limit	Remarks
(i)	For the posts for which age limit is 18-27 years	Candidate must have been born not earlier than 02-08-1996 and not later than 01-08-2005.
(ii)	For the posts for which age limit is 20-30 years	Candidate must have been born not earlier than 02-08-1993 and not later than 01-08-2003.
(iii)	For the posts for which age limit is 18-30 years	Candidate must have been born not earlier than 02-08-1993 and not later than 01-08-2005.
(iv)	For the post for which age limit is 18-32 years	Candidate must have been born not earlier than 02-08-1991 and not later than 01-08-2005.

Moreover, please note that age relaxation for reserved categories will be applied according to government norms. For your reference, we have included a table detailing the years of relaxation for various categories.

Code No	Category	Age-relaxation permissible beyond upper age limit
01	SC/ST	5 years
02	OBC	3 years
03	PwBD (Unreserved)	10 years
04	PwBD (OBC)	13 years
05	PwBD (SC/ST)	15 years
06	Ex-Servicemen (ESM)	3 years after deduction of the military service rendered from the actual age as on the closing date.
08	Defence Personnel disabled in operation during hostilities with any foreign country or in a disturbed area and released as a consequence thereof	3 years
09	Defence Personnel disabled in operation during hostilities with any foreign country or in a disturbed area and released as a consequence thereof (SC/ST)	8 years

Educational Qualifications

For the crucial eligibility of SSC CGL related to educational qualifications, specific requirements vary based on the desired posts:

Junior Statistical Officer:

- A bachelor's degree in any subject with at least 60% marks in mathematics at the 12th standard level is required.
- Alternatively, a bachelor's degree in any subject with statistics as one of the subjects at the degree level is acceptable.

Statistical Investigator Grade-II:

- A bachelor's degree in any subject with statistics as one of the subjects is required.
- It is necessary to have studied statistics for all three years or all six semesters of your graduation course.

Eligibility of SSC CGL - Age, Education

Research Assistant at the National Human Rights Commission (NHRC):

- The essential qualification is a bachelor's degree.
- Desirable qualifications include a minimum of one year of research experience at any recognized university or research institution, or a degree in law or human rights from a recognized university.

All other posts:

- A bachelor's degree from a recognized university or its equivalent is required.
- If you are in the final year of your graduation, you are still eligible to apply.
