Nationality

Age Limit

The age limit for candidates applying for this position falls between 20 and 28 years. To be eligible, you should have been born between September 2, 1995, and September 1, 2003, inclusive of both dates. Sr. No	Category	Relaxation in Age
(i)	Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe (SC / ST)	By 5 years, i.e., up to 33 years
(ii)	Other Backward Classes (OBC)	By 3 years, i.e., up to 31 years
(iii)	Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD)	By 10 years (GEN/EWS), 13 years (OBC) & 15 years (SC/ST)
(iv)	Ex-Servicemen	To the extent of service rendered by them in Armed Forces plus an additional period of 3 years subject to maximum of 50 years.
(v)	Widows/divorced women/women judicially separated who are not re-married	Up to 35 years (40 years for SC/ST)
(vi)	Candidates having work experience in Reserve Bank of India	To the extent of number of years of such experience, subject to maximum of 3 years

Educational Qualifications

Candidates applying for the RBI Assistant 2023 examination should possess the following educational qualifications:

- You must have a bachelor's degree in any discipline with a minimum of 50% marks (if you're from the SC/ST/PwBD category, passing marks are sufficient) and be knowledgeable in word processing on a PC.
- If you're an ex-serviceman (excluding dependents of ex-servicemen), you should either hold a graduate degree from a recognised university or have passed the matriculation or its equivalent exam from the Armed Forces and served for at least 15 years in defence.
- If you're applying for a post in a specific recruiting office, you should be proficient in the language spoken and understood in that state or any of the states under that recruiting office. This means you should be able to read, write, speak, and understand the local language.
