

RPSC Grade 2 Eligibility Criteria 2023 - Age, Education

RPSC Grade 2 Eligibility Criteria 2023

It is an undeniable fact that you must know your eligibility by reading the RPSC Grade 2 eligibility criteria 2023 mentioned in the notification before you start preparing for this exam. In order to be eligible to take the RPSC Grade 2 exam in 2023, you must know and understand the RPSC Grade 2 eligibility criteria 2023. There are three primary RPSC Grade 2 Eligibility Criteria 2023 as per the notification. These include:

Nationality

To be eligible for the RPSC Grade 2 Exam 2023, you must be an Indian citizen whose state of domicile is Rajasthan. Thus, nationality is the first RPSC Grade 2 eligibility criteria 2023. Remember, you cannot apply for a post if you are not a resident of Rajasthan, being only an Indian will not suffice.

Age Limit

RPSC Grade 2 Eligibility Criteria 2023 - Age, Education

Our second RPSC Grade 2 eligibility criteria 2023 is the age. Thus, you must be a minimum of 18 years old and a maximum of 40 years old as of **01.01.2024**.

Permissible relaxations in the upper age limit for different categories in accordance with the exact rules and guidelines of the Government of India are as follows:

3.	सामान्य (अनारक्षित) वर्ग की महिला Women Candidates belonging to General Category	5 वर्ष Five Years
4.	विधवा एवं विच्छिन्न विवाह (परित्यक्ता) महिला Explanation :- In the case of a widow, she will have to furnish a certificate of death of her husband from the Competent Authority and in case of divorce, she will have to furnish proof of divorce.	अधिकतम आयु सीमा नहीं
5.	उपरोक्त उच्चतम आयु सीमा उस मृतपूर्व कैदी के मामले में लागू नहीं होगी जो दोषसिद्धि से पूर्व सरकार के अधीन किसी पद पर Substantive तौर पर सेवा कर चुका था और इन नियमों के अधीन नियुक्ति के पात्र था। The upper age limit mentioned above shall not apply in the case of an ex-prisoner who had served under the Government on a substantive basis on any post before his/her conviction and was eligible for appointment under these Rules.	
6.	उस मृतपूर्व कैदी के मामले में जो अपनी दोषसिद्धि के पूर्व अधिकार्य नहीं था और नियमों के अधीन नियुक्ति के लिए पात्र था, उपरिर्णित अधिकतम आयु सीमा में उसके द्वारा मुक्त कारावास की कालावधि के बराबर की अवधि की छूट दी जाएगी। The upper age limit mentioned above shall be relaxed by a period equal to the term of imprisonment served in the case of other ex-prisoners who was not over age before his conviction and was eligible for appointment under these Rules.	
7.	कैडेट इन्स्ट्रक्टर के मामले में उतने ही काल की छूट होगी जितनी सेवा उन्होंने एन.सी.सी. में की होगी बशर्ते परिणामित आयु अधिकतम आयु सीमा से 3 वर्ष से अधिक नहीं होगी तो उन्हें निर्धारित आयु सीमा में ही समझा जाएगा। The upper age limit mentioned above shall be relaxed by a period equal to the service rendered in the N.C.C. in the case of Cadet Instructors, if the resultant age does not exceed the prescribed maximum age limit by more than three years, they shall be deemed to be within the prescribed age limit.	
8.	पंचायत समितियों तथा जिला परिषदों के कारोबार में Substantive रूप से कार्यरत व्यक्तियों के लिए अधिकतम आयु सीमा 40 वर्ष होगी। The upper age limit for persons serving in connection with the affairs of the State, Panchayat Samities and Zila Parishads and in the State Public Sector Undertaking/Corporations in substantive capacity shall be 40 years.	
9.	निर्मुक्त हुए आपातकालीन कमीशन प्राप्त अधिकारियों और लघु सेवा कमीशन प्राप्त अधिकारियों को सेना से निर्मुक्त होने के पश्चात् आयु सीमा में ही समझा जाएगा चाहे उन्होंने आयोग के सम्मिल उपस्थित होने के समय आयु सीमा पार कर ली हो बशर्ते कि वे सेना में कमीशन ग्रहण करने के समय आयु सीमा की दृष्टि से पात्र थे। The Released Emergency Commissioned Officers and Short Service Commissioned Officers after release from the Army shall be deemed to be within the age limit even though they have crossed the age limit when they appear before the Commission, Board or Appointing Authority, as the case may be, had they been eligible as such at the time of their joining the Commission in the Army.	
10.	इस सेवा के किसी पद पर अस्थायी नियुक्त व्यक्ति अगर प्रारम्भिक नियुक्ति के समय आयु सीमा में थे तो उन्हें आयु सीमा में समझा जाएगा चाहे वे आयोग के सम्मिल आखिरी उपस्थिति के समय उसे पार कर चुके हों और यदि वे उनकी प्रारम्भिक नियुक्ति के समय इस प्रकार पात्र थे तो उन्हें दो अवसर दिये जावेंगे। The persons appointed temporarily to a post in the Service shall be deemed to be within the age-limit, if they were within the age limit when they were initially appointed even though they have crossed the age-limit when they appear finally before the Commission/Board/Appointing Authority and shall be allowed up to two chances had they been eligible as such, at the time of their initial appointment.	
12.	राजस्थान सिविल सेवा (भूतपूर्व सैनिकों का आगमन) नियम, 1988 के अनुसार भूतपूर्व सैनिकों को अधिकतम आयु सीमा में 15 वर्ष की छूट देय होगी परन्तु इन नियमों के अधीन शिथिलीकरण के पश्चात् यदि अनुज्ञेय आयु 50 वर्ष से अधिक निकलती है तो ऊपरी आयु सीमा 50 वर्ष लागू होगी किन्तु सीधी भर्ती की दशा में जहां निम्नतर पद का अनुभव अनिवार्य है वहां 55 वर्ष की अधिकतम ऊपरी आयु सीमा लागू होगी। According to the Rajasthan Civil Services (Absorption of Ex-servicemen) Rules 1988, relaxation in upper age limit shall be ten years for Ex-servicemen; Provided that if permissible age after relaxation under this rule works out to be more than 50 years, then upper age limit of 50 years shall be applicable but in case of direct recruitment, where experience of lower post is essential, the maximum upper age limit of 55 years shall be applicable. स्पष्टीकरण :- कार्मिक (क-2) विभाग के परिपत्र दिनांक 22.8.2019 के अनुसार राजस्थान सिविल सेवा (भूतपूर्व सैनिकों का आगमन) नियम, 1988 यथासंशोधित प्रावधानों के होते हुए भी किसी भर्ती से संबंधित सेवा नियमों में आयु संबंधी जो शिथिलता अन्य लोक सेवकों/अभ्यर्थियों को देय है, वह भूतपूर्व सैनिक को भी देय होगी अर्थात् आयु संबंधी शिथिलता के संबंध में दोनों नियमों में जो भी हितकर प्रावधान है, उसका लाभ भूतपूर्व सैनिकों को मिलेगा।	
13.	राजस्थान दिव्यांगजन अधिकार नियम, 2018 के अनुसार निशक्तजन व्यक्तियों के लिए ऊपर उल्लिखित ऊपरी आयु सीमा में 05 वर्ष की छूट देय होगी। According to the Rajasthan Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules 2018, the upper age limit mentioned above shall be relaxed by 05 years for persons with benchmarks disabilities.

Educational Qualification

Last but not the least our third RPSC Grade 2 eligibility criteria 2023 is the educational qualification. Thus, if you are a person who has appeared or is about to appear in the last year of the required educational qualification for the post will also be eligible to apply, but you will have to provide proof of acquiring the educational qualification before the competitive examination conducted by the Commission.

**RPSC Grade 2 Eligibility Criteria 2023 - Age, Education**

Subject	Eligibility
Hindi, English, Maths, Sanskrit, Urdu, Punjabi, Sindhi	Bachelor's degree in a related subject is preferred but not mandatory, while a degree or diploma in education (e.g., B.Ed or DEEd) is also acceptable.
Social Science	Bachelor's degree with a minimum of two subjects chosen from History, Geography, Economics, Political Science, Sociology, Public Administration, or Philosophy as optional subjects. Additionally, a degree or diploma in education is also necessary.
Science	A Bachelor's degree with a minimum of two optional subjects chosen from Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Botany, Microbiology, Biotechnology, and Biochemistry. Additionally, a degree or diploma in education is also necessary.

RPSC Grade 2 Exam Pattern 2023

What is the next most important thing to know after the RPSC Grade 2 eligibility criteria 2023? We think it is the exam pattern of any exam. Do you know why it is important to know the exam pattern, before preparing for any exam? If not, then let's first understand its importance.

- Firstly, the exam pattern is a foundational step in preparing effectively and performing well in any examination.
- Secondly, it provides you with a roadmap that guides your preparation.

Now that, we understand its importance, let's move forward to the RPSC exam pattern. There are two Computer Based Examination in RPSC recruitment exam i.e., Paper 1 and Paper 2. Further, the selection process is as follows:

Paper 1

- It will consist of 100 questions of 2 marks each i.e. 200 marks in total.
- Further, a time limit of 120 minutes i.e. 2 hours will be given to you.
- Moreover, negative marking of 1/3rd marks will be done for every wrong answer.

Paper 2

- The paper will consist of 150 questions of 2 marks each i.e. 300 marks in total.
- Further, a time limit of 2 hours 30 minutes will be given to you.
- Consequently, negative marking of 1/3rd marks will be done for every wrong answer.
