

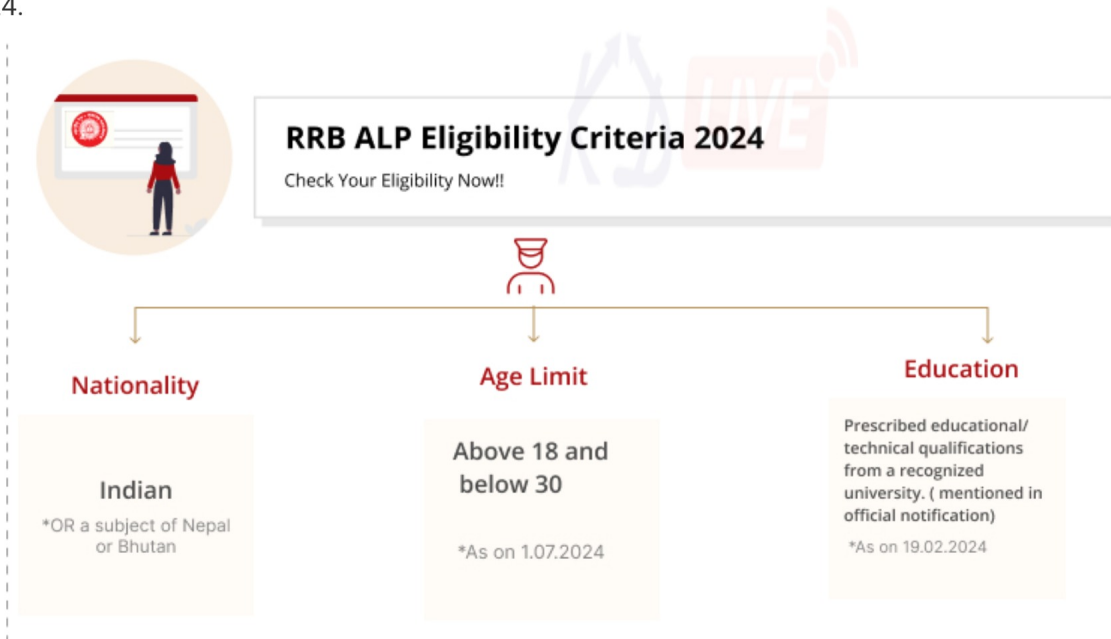

Nationality

The following conditions are essential for determining nationality:.

RRB ALP Eligibility Criteria 2024 - Age, Education

- You must be a citizen of India, Nepal, or Bhutan.
- A Tibetan refugee who arrived in India prior to January 1, 1962, with the intention of permanently settling in India, or
- Individuals of Indian origin migrating from Pakistan, Guyana, Sri Lanka, or East African countries such as Kenya, Uganda, and the United Republic of Tanzania (formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar) are eligible, provided they have the intention of permanently settling in India.

Most importantly, candidates falling into the last two categories must possess a certificate of eligibility issued by the state government to fulfill the RRB ALP Eligibility Criteria 2024.

Age Limit (as on 01/07/2024)

One's age must not be below 18 and above 30 years as July 01, 2024.

However, there will be upper age relaxation for 3 and 5 years for OBC (NCL) and SC/ST aspirants, respectively.

Educational Qulaification

- The candidate should have passed the matriculation exam from a recognised state or central board, and he or she must hold an ITI Trade certificate in the respective discipline from SCVT or NCVT.
- Also, a candidate must have completed a 3-year Diploma in Mechanical, Electrical, Electronics, or Automobile Engineering or pursued a Bachelor's degree in Engineering from an AICTE-recognised institution.

Physical and Medical Standards

It is important for the candidates who are planning to take the RRB ALP exam in 2024 to be fit both physically and medically. The medical standard should be A-1, and the eye vision of the candidates should be as per the data tabulated below.

Moreover, this forthcoming announcement will furnish essential information such as examination dates, available positions, application procedures, fees, eligibility criteria, selection process, salary details, and other pertinent particulars.

RRB ALP Exam Pattern 2024 - Overview

RRB ALP Eligibility Criteria 2024 - Age, Education

Before we jump into the RRB ALP exam pattern 2024, it's essential to grasp its importance. The exam pattern plays a crucial role in shaping your study plan, as it provides insights into how questions are distributed and structured within the exam. This, in turn, helps you prepare more effectively and with greater confidence. RRB's first stage for Assistant Loco Pilot posts of CBT and the second stage of CBT are both online objective-type papers. Furthermore, the last stage for the RRB ALP exam is CBAT.

- CBT 1 consists of 75 questions from four subjects: Mathematics, Mental Ability, General Science, and general Awareness of Current affairs.
- Further, CBT 2, Part A, covers questions from subjects like Mathematics, General Intelligence & Reasoning, and Basic Science & Engineering and Part B will be based on Relevant Trades
- Moreover, there is a negative marking of the $\frac{1}{3}$ rd mark for each incorrect answer in both stages.
- If you clear CBT 2, you will move on to the Computer-Based Aptitude Test (CBAT), and there is no negative marking in this round.
