

SBI SO Eligibility Criteria 2023 - Age, Education

The State Bank of India has recently released the official notification for the SBI SO 2023 exam, and it's an exciting time for aspiring banking professionals. Age Limit

Firstly, the age criteria for the SBI SO Exam 2023 are as follows:

- The minimum and maximum age limits to apply for any of the SBI SO 2023 posts vary from 21 years to 45 years, **as on 30.04.2023.**

However, age relaxations are provided for candidates belonging to reserved categories. For which you can refer to [pages 2 and 3](#) of the official notification. It's essential to check the official notification for any changes or updates in the age criteria.

Educational Qualification

Secondly, the educational qualification for SBI SO Exam 2023 is as follows for all posts (as on 30.04.2023):

- **Bachelor of Engineering or Bachelor of Technology** (Computer Science/ Computer Science & Engineering/ Information Technology/ Electronics/ Electronics & Communications Engineering/ Software Engineering or equivalent degree in above specified discipline)
- **MCA or M Tech/ M.Sc** in (Computer Science/ Computer Science & Engineering/ Information Technology/ Electronics/ Electronic & Communications Engineering or equivalent degree in above specified discipline) from a University/ Institution/ Board recognized by Govt of India/ approved by Govt Regulatory Bodies.

Qualification Experience

Lastly, the candidates are required a qualification experience for the SBI SO Exam 2023 as follows:

- The candidate should hold 2 Years of work experience for graduate and 1 year for Post-graduate.
- Minimum 36 months' post-qualification experience in the area of handling projects in the field of Environmental and related area / understanding of various climate mitigation technologies and ESG risk management under various sector specially power/steel/cement.
- Working in any financial institution/Bank/Rating company may be an added advantage.

- The SBI SO Notification 2023 was released by the State Bank of India on via its official website.
- The application forms for SBI Specialist Officer started on September 16, 2023 and the last date to fill the application is October 6, 2023.
- The SBI SO exam 2023, is being held to fill around 439 vacancies. Junior Management Grade Scale One, Middle Management Grade Scale Two, Middle Management Grade Scale Three, Senior Management Grade Scale Four, Senior Management Grade Scale Five.
- This notification contains vital information about the SBI SO Exam Date 2023, as well as other crucial details such as important dates, exam pattern, and syllabus.

SBI SO 2023 Important Dates

This data confirms that the official notification for SBI SO was issued on June 1, 2023 with the last date for application submission June 28, 2023. Now let us take you on an exam dates tour. Firstly, the online exam is scheduled for December 2023/January 2024. Secondly, the interview will only be conducted after the results for the online exams are out. So buckle up!

SBI SO 2023 Exam Pattern

Now that you have all the confirmed and expected dates, let's provide you with a quick summary of the SBI SO exam pattern for 2023. The State Bank of India (SBI) has revealed 439 openings for specialist officers in its SBI SO Notification 2023. The SBI SO exam will be conducted in two phases. Furthermore, the online test is divided into 2 parts (General Aptitude and professional Knowledge), of which General Aptitude is a qualifying test nature, and an interview round.

Let's delve into **Phase-1** of the exam pattern which consists of 2 parts in which the online test is conducted.

Phase 1 - Online Written Examination

• Part-1: General Aptitude

The 1st Part is the initial phase of the SBI SO Exam Date 2023. To proceed to the next round, you must pass this stage. The General Aptitude test includes an online objective test worth **120 marks**, and will have three subjects that you have to complete in 90 minutes i.e. 1hr 30 minutes. This test is qualifying in nature by which the candidates can appear for Part-2 test and the Interview.

• Part-2: Professional Knowledge

The SBI SO 2023 Exam Part-2 test is conducted following Part-1 test. Only those who pass Part-1 can participate in this one. The Part-2 examination will be an online test comprising **2 subjects worth 150 marks which you have to complete in 70 minutes i.e 1hr 10 minutes.**

Interview Round

SBI SO Eligibility Criteria 2023 - Age, Education

The State Bank of India selected a number of candidates who all will be called for an Interview based on their performance in the online written test. This interview will carry 25 marks. The qualifying marks for the interview will be determined by the bank. The final selection of candidates will be based on their performance in the online written examination and interview. The weightage of the online test and interview is 70% and 30%.

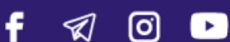
