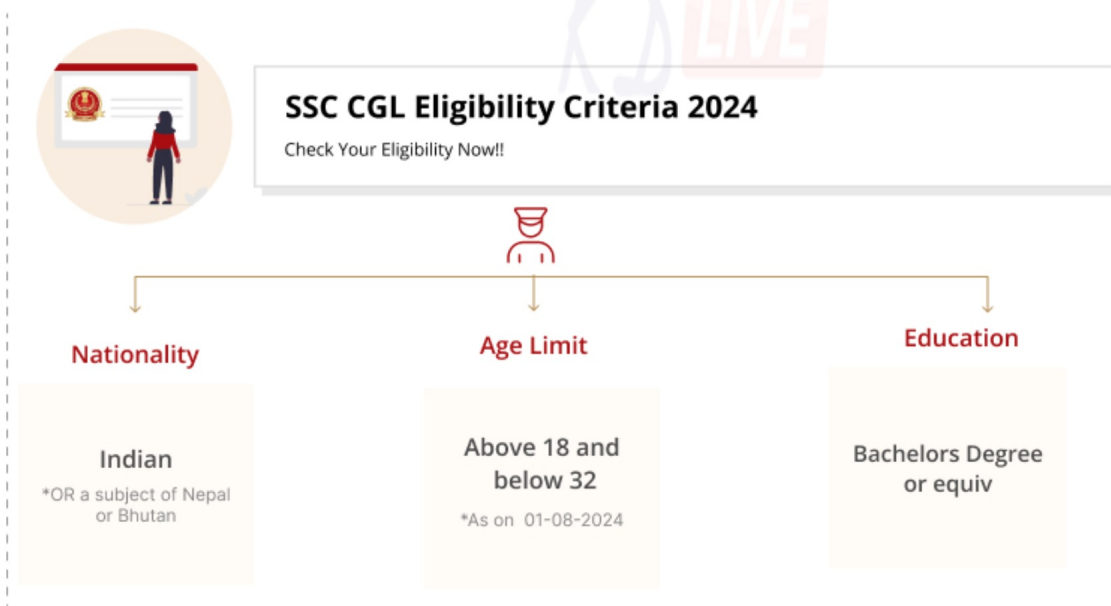

SSC CGL Eligibility Criteria 2024 - Overview

To be eligible for the SSC CGL exam in 2024, you need to be familiar with its eligibility criteria. You, as a candidate, must be aware of the three main SSC CGL Eligibility Criteria 2024 for the recruitment exam in the upcoming year. Nationality

The initial SSC CGL Eligibility Criteria 2024 revolves around Nationality. To qualify for the SSC CGL Exam 2024, you need to fit into one of the following categories:

SSC CGL Eligibility Criteria 2024 - Age, Education

1. Be an Indian citizen.
2. Be a subject of Nepal.
3. Be a subject of Bhutan.
4. Be a person of Indian origin who has relocated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, the East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania, Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia, and Vietnam with an intention of permanently settling in India.

Age

According to the second SSC CGL Eligibility Criteria 2024, you, as a candidate, can apply for the CGL examination if you fall within the age bracket of 18 to 32 years as on 01.08.2024. Also, check out the table below to learn about various posts and their corresponding age requirements. Just remember that these are based on SSC CGL Notification 2023, since 2024 is yet to be released:

S No	Age Limit	Remarks
(i)	For the posts for which age limit is 18-27 years	Candidate must have been born not earlier than 02-08-1997 and not later than 01-08-2006.
(ii)	For the posts for which age limit is 20-30 years	Candidate must have been born not earlier than 02-08-1994 and not later than 01-08-2004.
(iii)	For the posts for which age limit is 18-30 years	Candidate must have been born not earlier than 02-08-1994 and not later than 01-08-2006.
(iv)	For the posts for which age limit is 18-32 years	Candidate must have been born not earlier than 02-08-1992 and not later than 01-08-2006.

Moreover, note that the age relaxation for reserved categories will be applicable as per government norms. Thus, for your reference, we have attached the table containing the years of relaxation for various categories.

Code No	Category	Age-relaxation permissible beyond upper age limit
01	SC/ST	5 years
02	OBC	3 years
03	PwBD (Unreserved)	10 years
04	PwBD (OBC)	13 years
05	PwBD (SC/ST)	15 years
06	Ex-Servicemen (ESM)	3 years after deduction of the military service rendered from the actual age as on the closing date.
08	Defence Personnel disabled in operation during hostilities with any foreign country or in a disturbed area and released as a consequence thereof	3 years
09	Defence Personnel disabled in operation during hostilities with any foreign country or in a disturbed area and released as a consequence thereof (SC/ST)	8 years

Educational Qualifications

Another very crucial SSC CGL Eligibility Criteria 2024 is the educational qualification as on 01.08.2024. Remember that your specific requirements vary based on the desired posts:

Junior Statistical Officer:

- A bachelor's degree in any subject is a must, with at least 60% marks in mathematics at the 12th standard level.
- Alternatively, a bachelor's degree in any subject with statistics as one of the subjects at the degree level is also acceptable.

Statistical Investigator Grade-II:

- A bachelor's degree in any subject with statistics as one of the subjects is required.
- It's necessary to have studied statistics for all three years or all six semesters of your graduation course.

Research Assistant at the National Human Rights Commission (NHRC):

- The essential qualification is a bachelor's degree.
- Desirable qualifications include a minimum of one year of research experience at any recognised university or research institution or a degree in law or human rights from a recognised university.

All other posts:

- You need a bachelor's degree from a recognised university or its equivalent.
- If you are in the final year of your graduation, you are still eligible to apply.
