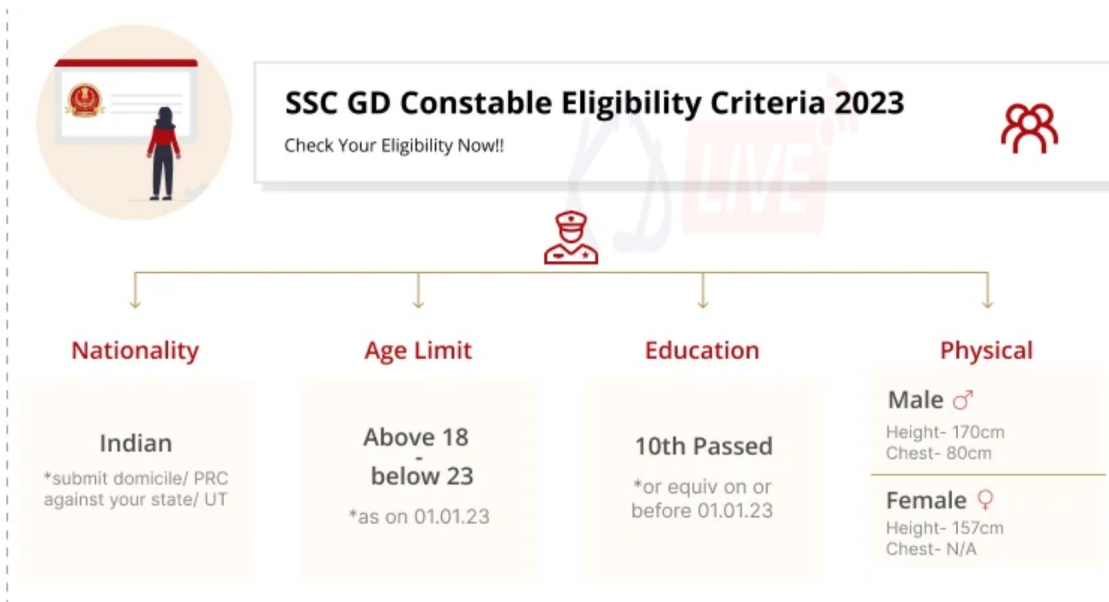


SSC GD Constable Eligibility Criteria 2023 - Age, Education

The young Indian Police Force aspirants felt quite the jitters when the Staff Selection Commission released the official **SSC GD Constable Notification 2023**. SSC GD Constable Eligibility Criteria 2023 Overview

It is an undeniable fact that the first and foremost step towards starting your preparation for any exam is to know your eligibility. Consequently, it is important for you to know and understand the SSC GD Constable Eligibility Criteria 2023. There are four primary eligibility criteria, scan through the image o know them.

Now that you have an idea regarding all the eligibility criteria. Let's dig deeper into each of the above shown criteria.

Nationality

Moreover, in order to be eligible for the exam, you must be a citizen of India. In addition to this, vacancies in CAPFs & AR are state/UT/area-wise, hence, you must submit domicile/ PRC against your state/ UT.

Age Limit

SSC GD Constable Eligibility Criteria 2023 - Age, Education

The age limit for being eligible for the exam is 18-23 years as of 01-01-2023. Moreover, you must not be born earlier than 2nd January 2000 and later than 1st January 2005. However, there are some relaxations provided for certain categories:

Code No	Category	Age-relaxation permissible beyond the upper age limit
01	SC/ ST	5 years
02	OBC	3 years
03	Ex-Servicemen	3 years after deduction of the military service rendered from the actual age as on the date of reckoning.
04	Children and dependent of victims killed in the 1984 riots or communal riots of 2002 in Gujarat (Unreserved)	5 years
05	Children and dependent of victims killed in the 1984 riots or communal riots of 2002 in Gujarat (OBC)	8 years
06	Children and dependent of victims killed in the 1984 riots or communal riots of 2002 in Gujarat (SC/ ST)	10 years

Educational Qualification

Furthermore, for the SSC GD Constable Eligibility Criteria 2023, you must have passed the Matriculation or 10th Class Examination from a recognized Board or University as on 01.01.2023. In case you have not acquired the essential educational qualification as of the stipulated date, you will not be eligible and need not to apply for the exam.

Physical Qualification

Lastly, the below mentioend requirements come under the Physical Standard Test (PST).

Height:

- Male: 170 cm
- Female: 157 cm

However, there are some relaxations as listed below:

Chest:

Further, female candidates are exempted from chest measurement. Male candidates, on the other hand, must have the following standards of chest measurement:

- Un-expanded: 80 cm
- Minimum expansion: 5 cm

Moreover, it is an obvious fact that one of the ultimate goals for a successful career is to earn a livelihood. The pay scale of a person varies according to the post they hold. Hence, the variation in the pay scale is as follows:

- **Sepoy in NCB:** The post of Sepoy carries a pay scale of Pay Level-1 (Rs. 18,000 to 56,900)
- **All other posts** carry a pay scale of Pay Level 3 (Rs. 21,700-69,100)

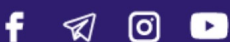
