

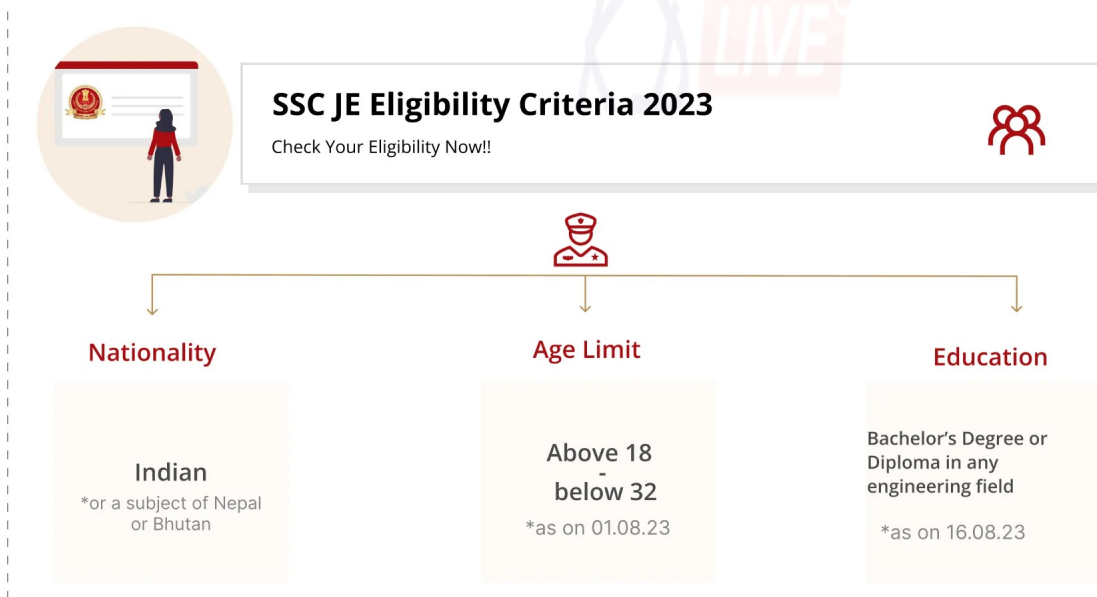
SSC JE Eligibility Criteria 2023 - Age, Education

The young Indians passionate about various fields of engineering must be thrilled as the Staff Selection Commission of India releases the **SSC JE Official Notification 2023**. Furthermore, in light of this exciting development, while some of you might be experiencing a slight sense of apprehension regarding this year's SSC JE eligibility criteria 2023, please rest assured, as the **KD Live** team is here to address all your concerns.. In this blog, we will primarily focus on the SSC JE Eligibility Criteria 2023 decided by the Staff Selection Commission of India.

SSC JE Eligibility Criteria 2023

The undeniable fact is that the first and foremost step towards starting your preparation for any exam is to know your SSC JE eligibility criteria 2023. Consequently, you need to know and understand the SSC JE eligibility criteria 2023 since your eligibility for the SSC JE Exam is dependent on three factors: nationality, age limit, and educational qualifications as described by SSC. This article will further provide you with the details of the SSC JE Eligibility Criteria 2023.

There are three primary SSC JE eligibility criteria 2023 for the recruitment exam in 2023:

Now, let's understand each of these SSC JE eligibility criteria 2023 in detail to clear all your doubts.

Nationality

Nationality is the first among the other SSC JE eligibility criteria 2023. Thus, to be eligible, you should meet the nationality requirements to be eligible for the SSC JE exam in 2023, as decided by the Staff Selection Commission.



SSC JE Eligibility Criteria 2023 - Age, Education

The details are as follows:

- You must be a citizen of India,
- You must be a subject of Nepal, Bhutan, or
- You must be an Indian who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, the East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia, and Vietnam with the intention of permanently setting up in India.

A very important point to take into consideration is that the latter two must fulfill all the SSC JE eligibility criteria 2023 requirements under the eligibility certificate issued by the government of India. Candidates whose certification of SSC JE eligibility criteria 2023 is mandatory can take the exam without the certification. However, the offer of appointment will be given to them only when the certificate of eligibility is issued to them by the Government of India.

Age Limit

Our second criteria under SSC JE eligibility criteria 2023 is the age limit. In order to grab one of these many JE posts in various Ministries, Departments, Organizations, you must ensure that your age meets the following SSC JE Eligibility Criteria 2023.

You need to properly go through the following table, as listed below, to understand the age limit SSC JE eligibility criteria 2023 for all the posts.

- You should be at least 18 years old and not more than 32 years old (**as on 01.08.2023**).
- **For the posts for which the age limit is up to 30 years:** You must have been born not earlier than 02-08-1993 and not later than 01-08-2005.
- **For the posts for which the age limit is up to 32 years:** You must have been born not earlier than 02-08-1991 and not later than 01-08-2005.

Permissible relaxations in the upper age limit for different categories in accordance with the exact rules and guidelines of the Government of India are as follows:

SSC JE Eligibility Criteria 2023 - Age, Education

Code	Category	Age-relaxation permissible beyond the upper age limit
01	SC/ST	5 years
02	OBC	3 years
03	PwD (Unreserved)	10 years
04	PwD (OBC)	13 years
05	PwD (SC/ST)	15 years
06	Ex-Servicemen (ESM)	3 years after deduction of the military service rendered from the actual age.
08	Defence Personnel disabled in operation during hostilities with any foreign country or in a disturbed area and released as a consequence thereof.	3 years
09	Defence Personnel disabled in operation during hostilities with any foreign country or in a disturbed area and released as a consequence thereof (SC/ST).	8 years

Educational Qualification

The educational qualifications for the SSC CPO Exam 2023 (as on 16.08.2023) is as follows:

- The SSC JE eligibility criteria 2023 require candidates to have a three-year diploma or degree in Civil, Electrical, Mechanical engineering from a recognised institute.
- Moreover, remember that each of these educational qualifications should be as on **16.08.2023**.

However, to provide you with complete detail on the education qualification, you can refer to the tables given below:

Organization	Post	Essential Educational Qualifications
	JE (C)	Degree in Civil Engineering from a recognized University/Institute; or (a) Three years Diploma in Civil Engineering from a recognized University/Institute/Board; and (b) Two years working experience in Planning/Execution/Maintenance of Civil Engineering works.
Border Roads Organization (BRO)	JE (E & M)	Degree in Electrical or Mechanical Engineering from a recognized University/Institute; or (a) Three years Diploma in Electrical/Automobile/Mechanical Engineering from a recognized University/Institute/ Board; and (b) Two years' experience in Planning/Execution/ Maintenance of Electrical or Mechanical Engineering works.
Central Public Works	JE (C)	Diploma in Civil Engineering from a recognized University or Institute.
Department (CPWD)	JE (E)	Diploma in Electrical or Mechanical Engineering from a recognized University or Institute.
	JE (C)	Bachelor's Degree or Diploma in Civil Engineering from a recognized University or Institution.

SSC JE Exam Pattern 2023

After knowing the important of SSC JE Eligibility Criteria 2023, let's understand why is it important to know the exam pattern, before preparing for any exam? If not, then let's first understand its importance. Firstly, the exam pattern is a foundational step in preparing effectively and performing well in any examination. Secondly, it provides you with a roadmap that guides your preparation. Lastly, it helps you navigate the actual exam and enhance your confidence.

Now that we understand its importance, let's move forward to the JE exam pattern. There are two Computer Based Examinations in SSC JE recruitment exam, i.e., Paper 1 and Paper 2. Further, the selection process is as follows:

- Paper 1 & Paper 2 will consist of Objective Type, Multiple-choice questions only. The questions will be set both in Hindi & English.
- To attempt the General Engineering part (i.e. Part-A, Part-B, or Part-C) in Paper-1 and Paper-2, which has been selected by them, based on their educational qualification, in the online application form.

SSC JE Eligibility Criteria 2023 - Age, Education

There are three posts of Group B (Non-Gazetted) of Non-Ministerial in Level 6 under the SSC JE examination 2023, which include:

- Junior Electrical Engineer
- Junior Mechanical Engineer
- Junior Civil Engineer

If you pass the SSC JE Eligibility Criteria 2023 and the examination, it is totally normal to be curious about the pay scale and its advantages. Moreover, the salary structure for the same lies in the pay matrix of 7th Central Pay Commission. But what does that actually mean?
