Nationality

To qualify for the SSC JHT Exam 2023, the very first SSC JHT eligibility criteria 2023 is nationality. Thus, a candidate must fit into one of the following categories:

SSC JHT Eligibility Criteria 2023 - Age, Education

- A citizen of India, a subject of Nepal, or a subject of Bhutan.
- A person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, etc to permanently settle in India. Moreover, the candidate belonging to the categories above shall be a person in whose favor a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Government of India which will help the candidate to get the offer of appointment.

Age Limit

The second SSC JHT eligibility criteria 2023 is the age limit. Thus, a candidate who wishes to take the SSC JHT Exam must be at least 18 years old and not older than 30 years as on 1st August 2023. In other words, those born between 2nd August 1993 and 1st August 2005, are eligible to submit their applications. However, permissible age relaxation is provided to certain candidates.

Firstly, you should understand the **educational qualification for the postcode "A" to "C"** in the official notification 2023. Read through the pointers below for better understanding:

- Master's degree of a recognized University in Hindi with English as a compulsory or elective subject or as the medium of examination at the degree level; or
- Master's degree of a recognized University in English with Hindi as a compulsory or elective subject or as the medium of examination at the degree level; or
- Master's degree of a recognized University in any subject other than Hindi or English, with Hindi medium and English as a compulsory or elective subject or as the medium of a examination at the degree level; or
- Master's degree of a recognized University in any subject other than Hindi or English, with English medium and Hindi as a compulsory or elective subject or as the medium of examination at the degree level; or
- Master's Degree of a recognized University in any subject other than Hindi or English, with Hindi and English as compulsory or elective subjects or either of the two as a medium of examination and the other as a compulsory or elective subject at degree level.
- Recognized Diploma or Certificate course in translation from Hindi to English & vice versa or two years' experience of translation work from Hindi to English and vice versa in Central or State Government Office, including Government of India Undertaking.

Secondly, we present to you the **educational qualification for the postcode "D"** as mentioned in the official notification 2023.

- Master's degree of a recognized University in Hindi with English as a compulsory or elective subject or as the medium of examination at the degree level; or
- Master's degree of a recognized University in English with Hindi as a compulsory or elective subject or as the medium of examination at the degree level; or
- Master's degree of a recognized University in any subject other than Hindi or English, with Hindi medium and English as a compulsory or elective subject or as the medium of examination at the degree level; or
- Master's degree of a recognized University in any subject other than Hindi or English, with English medium and Hindi as a compulsory or elective subject or as the medium of examination at the degree level; or
- Master's Degree of a recognized University in any subject other than Hindi or English, with Hindi and English as compulsory or elective subjects or either of the two as a medium of examination and the other as a compulsory or elective subject at degree level.
- Recognized Diploma or Certificate course in translation from Hindi to English & vice versa or three years' experience of translation work from Hindi to English and vice versa in Central or State Government Office, including Government of India Undertaking.
