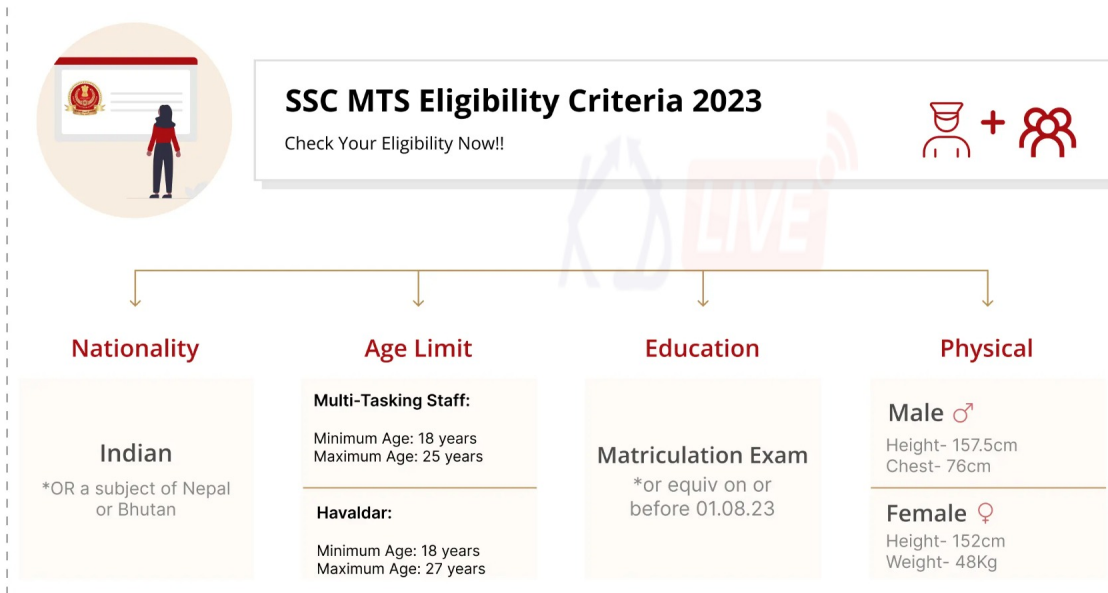


SSC MTS Eligibility Criteria 2023 - Age, Education

Now, let's understand each of the SSC MTS Eligibility Criteria 2023 in detail to clear all your doubts.

Nationality

To be eligible for the SSC MTS Exam 2023, you must be one of the following:

- A citizen of India
- A subject of Nepal or Bhutan
- A Tibetan refugee who came to India before 1st January 1962 with the intention of settling permanently in India
- A person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania, Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia, and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India

SSC MTS Eligibility Criteria 2023 - Age, Education

Age Limit (As on 01-08-2023)

For the SSC MTS Exam 2023, the following age criteria apply. Also, you must note that you cannot be born before 02.08.1996 and after 01.08.2005.

Multi-Tasking Staff (MTS) and Havaladar (CBN):

- Minimum Age: 18 years
- Maximum Age: 25 years

Havaladar (CBIC):

- Minimum Age: 18 years
- Maximum Age: 27 years

Exempted candidates: A son, daughter, or dependent of an ex-serviceman is not eligible for age relaxation/ESM reservation. Therefore, such candidates cannot indicate their category as ex-servicemen. Further for more details check the table below for category wise age relaxation:-

Code No.	Category	Age-relaxation permissible beyond the upper age limit
01	SC/ ST	5 years
02	OBC	3 years
03	PwBD (Unreserved)	10 years
04	PwBD (OBC)	13 years
05	PwBD (SC/ ST)	15 years
06	Ex-Servicemen (ESM)	03 years after deduction of the military service rendered from the actual age as on closing date of receipt of online application.
08	Defence Personnel disabled in operation during hostilities with any foreign country or in a disturbed area and released as a consequence thereof.	03 years
09	Defence Personnel disabled in operation during hostilities with any foreign country or in a disturbed area and released as a consequence thereof (SC/ ST)	08 years
10	Central Government Civilian Employees: Who have rendered not less than 3 years regular and continuous service as on closing date for receipt of online applications.	Up to 40 years of age.

11	Central Government Civilian Employees: Who have rendered not less than 3 years regular and continuous service as on closing date for receipt of online applications. (SC/ ST)	Up to 45 years of age.
12	Widows/ Divorced Women/ Women judicially separated and who are not remarried.	Up to 35 years of age.
13	Widows/ Divorced Women/ Women judicially separated and who are not remarried (SC/ ST).	Up to 40 years of age.

Educational Qualification (As on 01-08-2023)

The educational qualifications for the SSC MTS Exam 2023 are as follows:

- You should have passed your Matriculation (10th) Examination or its equivalent from a recognised board before the cut-off date (as on 01-08-2023).
- If you have not passed your qualifying examination before the closing date of receipt of the application, you will not be eligible to apply for the SSC MTS Exam 2023.

Physical Qualification

The Physical Efficiency Test (PET) and Physical Standard Test (PST) are only for the post of Havaldar. For males, PET includes walking 1600 metres in 15 minutes. Whereas, for women, it is walking 1 kilometre in 20 minutes. Moreover, for the post of Havaldar, there is a minimum physical standard in CBIC and CBN for men and women. As mentioned in the official notification, the following are the details announced by the Staff Selection Commission (SSC) of India:

Male:

Height	Chest
157.5 cms. (relaxable by 5 cms. in the case of Garhwalis, Assamese, Gorkhas and members of Schedule Tribes)	81 cms. (fully expanded with minimum expansion of 5 cms.)

Female:

Height	Weight
152 cms. (relaxable by 2.5 cms in the case of Garhwalis, Assamese, Gorkhas and members of Schedule Tribes)	48 kg (relaxable by 2 Kg in the case of Garhwalis, Assamese, Gorkhas and members of Schedule Tribes)

- The SSC MTS Notification PDF was released on 30th June 2023 on the official [SSC website](#).
- As per the notification, the SSC MTS exam aims to fill approximately 1558 vacancies for various posts.
- The above-given vacancies are inclusive of Multi-Tasking staff, and Havaladar (CBIC and CBN).
- Moreover, this is an annually recurring recruitment examination conducted by the Staff Selection Commission of India.

SSC MTS Exam Dates 2023

As per the Staff Selection Commission of India the application was opened on the 30th June 2023 and the selection process i.e., CBE will be conducted from the **1st September to 14th September 2023**.

Admit cards	29th August 2023

Upon successful application for SSC MTS 2023, the admit cards will be released on 29th August 2023. SSC MTS Exam Pattern 2023

- Firstly, the Computer Based Examinations for Session 1 and Session 2 will be held for the SSC MTS 2023 examination.
- Secondly, the candidates will undergo a **Physical Standard Test (PST) or Physical Endurance Test (PET)**.
- Lastly, there will be a Detailed Medical Examination done for each candidate.
