# SSC CPO Exam Details - Eligibility Criteria

Are you prepared to apply for the SSC CPO 2024 Exam? First, let's confirm that you meet the criteria required to be eligible for the SSC CPO exam! These

requirements

are outlined below:

- Nationality: You must be either a citizen of India or a subject of Nepal or Bhutan.
- Age Limit (as on 01.08.2024): Your age should range between 20 and 25 years.
- Educational Qualification: A bachelor's degree from a recognized university or its equivalent is required.
- For the post of Sub Inspector in Delhi Police only: Male applicants are required to hold a valid LMV (Motorcycle and Car) driving license on the designated date for Physical Endurance and Measurement Tests to be eligible for the post of Sub Inspector in Delhi Police. Nevertheless, candidates lacking a valid LMV (Motorcycle and Car) driving license are eligible for the post of Sub Inspector in CAPFs only.

### CPO Exam Details - Know Eligibility and Exam Pattern

- Sub-Inspector (GD) in CAPFs: This position offers a pay scale at Level-6, ranging from Rs. 35,400 to Rs. 1,12,400. It is classified as Group 'B' (Non-Gazetted), Non-Ministerial. This classification indicates that while the post is part of the central government's organizational structure, it does not hold gazetted status and is not involved in clerical or administrative duties.
- Sub-Inspector (Executive) (Male/Female) in Delhi Police: This role provides a pay scale at Level-6, with a salary range of Rs. 35,400 to Rs. 1,12,400. It is classified as Group 'C' by the Delhi Police. This classification denotes a position within the rank and file of the police force, focused on operational duties rather than administrative responsibilities.

## SSC CPO Exam Details - Selection Process


Another important detail about the SSC CPO Exam is the selection process for 2024, which comprises four stages: First, you'll encounter Paper I, followed by the Physical Standard Test (PST) and the Physical Endurance Test (PET). After these, you will take Paper II, and finally, you will undergo the Detailed Medical Examination (DME). It is crucial to note that all these stages of the examination are mandatory and must be successfully completed to progress in the selection process.

#### CPO Exam Details - Know Eligibility and Exam Pattern

- Paper I includes four subjects: General Intelligence and Reasoning, General Knowledge and General Awareness, Quantitative Aptitude, and English Comprehension.
- The exam consists of 200 questions, each carrying 1 mark, making the total possible score 200.
- You will have 2 hours (120 minutes) to complete this paper.
- There is no penalty for leaving questions unanswered.
- However, each incorrect response will incur a penalty of 0.25 marks.

Let's now move on to SSC CPO Paper II:

- In Paper II, there is only one subject which is English language & Comprehension.
- This paper consists of 200 questions, each worth 1 mark.
- You will have a total of 2 hours (120 minutes) to navigate through these questions.
- There is no penalty for leaving a question unanswered. However, for each incorrect response, 0.25 marks will be deducted.

# SSC CPO Exam Details - Application Process

You are required to submit your application online exclusively through the official website. The fee payable is Rs. 100/-(Rupees One Hundred only). However, if you are a woman candidate or belong to the Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), or are an Ex-Serviceman eligible for reservation, you are exempted from paying this fee. You can pay the fee only through online payment methods such as BHIM UPI, Net Banking, or by using a Visa, MasterCard, Maestro, or RuPay credit or debit card.

The following are the steps to apply for the SSC CCPO exam:

· Visit the latest

official website of SSC

- To create a new account, click "Apply" or "New User Registration."
- Enter your generated ID and password to log in.
- Complete the form with your contact information and educational background.
- Scan your signature and photo, then upload them.
- · Whether offline or online, pay the application cost.
- Check that everything is correct on the form and then submit it.
- · Keep the acknowledgement you get in your files for future use.
