

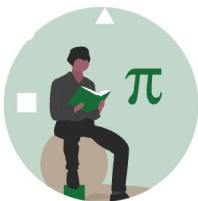

- The time allotted is 90 minutes for Paper I, 120 minutes for Paper II, and 120 minutes for Paper III.

Only such candidates who score the minimum cut off marks or above in the Main Examination will be shortlisted for interview. The final selection and ranking of the applicants for the post of Manager in Grade 'B' (RDBS) will be based on their performance in the Phase-II Main Examination and Interview, taken together. NABARD Grade B Marking Scheme 2023

Regarding the marking system of the exam, you'll receive 1 mark for each correct response, but for every incorrect choice, a deduction of 0.25 marks will be made. In the main exam, a correct answer will earn you 2 marks, while an incorrect response will result in a deduction of 0.50 marks.
