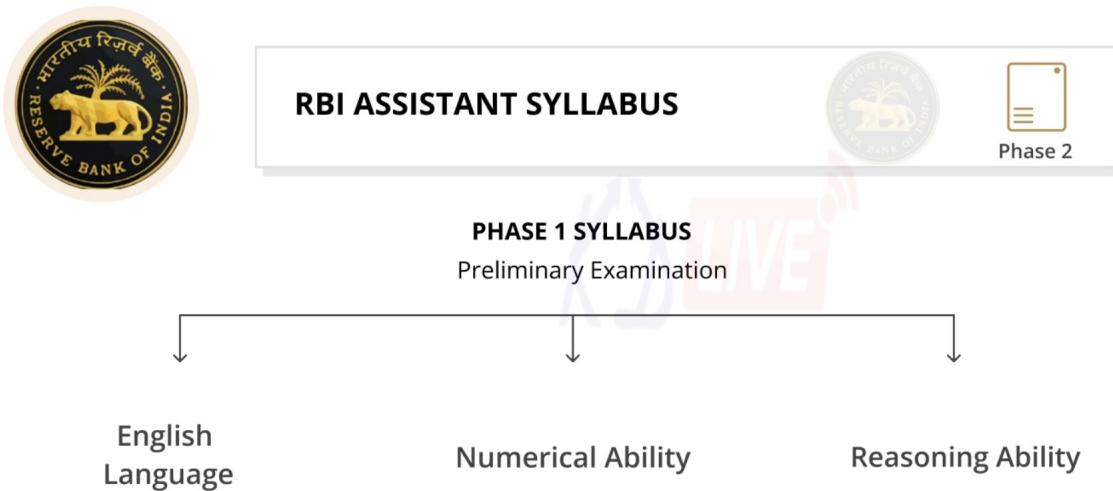

RBI Assistant 2023 Exam Pattern- Prelims Exam

Now, let's move on to the official RBI Assistant Exam Pattern 2023. The preliminary examination is the first step in the RBI Assistant selection process. Paper 1 is conducted as a Computer-Based Examination.

- There will be 100 questions divided into three sections: English Language, Numerical Ability, and Reasoning Ability.
- The RBI Assistant Prelims Exam has a total duration of 60 minutes, with each section allocated 20 minutes.
- For every wrong answer, there will be a deduction of one-fourth marks, but no marks will be subtracted for unanswered questions.
- All questions in the preliminary exam will be of the objective type.
- While English-language questions will be in English only, the other sections will be available in both English and Hindi.
- Importantly, the marks obtained in the preliminary exam will not be considered in the merit list, as the preliminary exam is meant to be a qualifying stage.

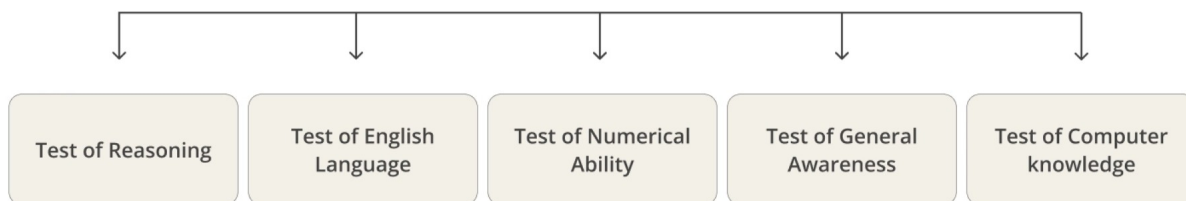

RBI Assistant Exam Pattern 2023 - 100 Questions in 60 Minutes

- The RBI Assistant Mains Exam comprises 200 questions distributed across five sections: English Language, Numerical Ability, Computer Knowledge, General Awareness, and Reasoning.
- The total time duration for the RBI Assistant Mains Exam is 135 minutes, with specific timings allocated for each section (section-wise timing is detailed below).
- For incorrect answers, there's a penalty. One-fourth of the marks assigned to a question will be deducted for every wrong answer. However, no marks are deducted for unanswered questions.
- All questions in the Mains Exam are of the objective type.
- While the English Language section is presented in English only, the other sections are available in both English and Hindi languages.
- It's important to note that the marks obtained in the Mains Exam are considered in preparing the merit list. Candidates who qualify for the Mains Exam will proceed to the Language Proficiency Test (LPT).

This test will be conducted in the official or local language of the respective State, as specified below. It's important to note that candidates lacking proficiency in the official or local language will face disqualification.

Moreover, the selection of candidates for the Language Proficiency Test will be based on their merit in the mains examination. The bank will determine this merit relative to the number of announced vacancies to be filled.
