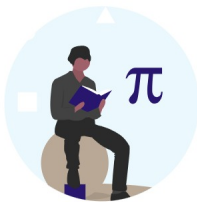

- Mains Examination
- Test of specified opted local language

SBI Clerk Exam Pattern 2023 - Preliminary Examination

To start, it's important to grasp the SBI Clerk Exam Pattern 2023 for the Preliminary exam.

- It is a Computer Based Exam.
- A time limit of 60 minutes i.e. 1 hour will be given to you for this exam.
- This will have 3 sections and each section will have to be completed in a time frame of 20 Minutes.
- Each question will be worth one mark.
- Negative marking of 1/4th of the assigned marks will be done for every wrong answer.
- A total of 100 questions for 100 marks have to be answered by you.

Further, the Preliminary exam consists of three subjects:

1. English Language
2. Numerical Ability
3. Reasoning Ability

SBI Clerk Exam Pattern 2023 - Mains Examination

Similarly, talking about the SBI Clerk Exam Pattern 2023 for the Mains exam.

- It is a Computer Based Exam.
- There will be 190 questions in the objective test, and separate time is allotted for each sentence.
- In total, the main examination will be for 200 marks in total.
- A time limit of 2 hours + 40 minutes will be given to each candidate for this exam.
- Negative marking of 1/4th of the assigned marks will be done for every wrong answer.

Moreover, the Mains exam consists of 4 subjects.

1. General/ Financial Awareness
2. General English
3. Quantitative Aptitude
4. Reasoning Ability and Computer Aptitude

Once you've successfully cleared Prelims and Mains you will advance to phase 3 which will include the Test of the specified opted local language. Here, the authorities will assess your suitability for the post of Clerk (Junior Assistant) in SBI.

SBI Clerk 2023 - Local Language Test

Language tests will not be administered to candidates who qualify for selection and show proof of studying the specified opted local language in their 10th or 12th grade mark sheets. In the case of others (qualified for selection), a specified opted local language test will be conducted after provisional selection but before joining. Candidates not found proficient in the specified opted local language would be disqualified.

This notification will pertain to the recruitment of Junior Associates (Customer Support and Sales) for various branches of the State Bank of India throughout India. SBI Clerk 2023 Syllabus

The SBI Clerk syllabus is comprehensive, covering crucial topics with maximum weightage, along with other relevant details. In the Prelims exam, there are 100 questions that candidates must complete within 60 minutes. On the other hand, the SBI Clerk Mains exam consists of 190 questions to be solved within 160 minutes. Key topics for the SBI Clerk exam include Reading Comprehension, Cloze Test, Simplification, Data Interpretation, Puzzles, Seating Arrangement, and Number Series.

The computer based examination will be conducted in three phases: Prelims, Mains, and test for opted local language. Further, the syllabus for the SBI Clerk Examination 2023 carries a different set of knowledge for each paper.

- For each correct answer, candidates are awarded one mark.
- However, it's important to note that for every incorrect answer, a deduction of 1/4th of a mark is applied.
