SSC CGL Marking Scheme 2024 - Overview

The Staff Selection Commission of India will conduct the forthcoming **SSC CGL 2024** examination in two distinct stages, or tiers. Furthermore, the recruitment examination for **SSC CGL** is comprised of Computer Based Examinations. Initially, Tier 1 encompasses a CBE within the **SSC CGL** assessment. Subsequently, Tier 2, also conducted as a Computer Based Exam, encompasses the **SSC CGL** Examination across three distinct papers.

Additionally, it is essential to note that while the Tier 1 examination is mandatory for all candidates, the Tier 2 examination is exclusively reserved for those who successfully clear the Tier 1 stage. For a more detailed and comprehensive overview, please refer to the infographic provided below:

SSC CGL Marking Scheme 2024 - All that you need to know!

According to the Exam Pattern and SSC CGL Marking Scheme 2024, the SSC CGL Tier 1 exam consists of 100 MCQ questions. You will have 60 minutes (one hour) to answer the question of Tier 1. Take a look at the snippet below for better reference:

- The SSC CGL Tier 1 exam comprises 100 questions, evenly distributed among four subjects, with each subject containing 25 questions.
- For every correct answer, you'll receive 1 mark.
- Moreover, there will be a negative marking of 0.50 for each wrong answer. Thus, be cautious while answering questions.
- Lastly, it is important to note that no marks will be deducted for unanswered questions.

SSC CGL Marking Scheme 2024 - Tier 2

According to the SSC CGL Marking Scheme 2024, the SSC CGL Tier 2 Examination will have 3 papers– Paper 1, Paper 2 and Paper 3. Paper 1 will be compulsory for all the candidates who have qualified for the SSC CGL Tier 1 exam. Paper 2 is for candidates applying for Junior Statistical Officer (JSO) posts in the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, while Paper III is for candidates applying for Assistant Audit Officer/Assistant Accounts Officer positions. Furthermore, the SSC CGL Marking Scheme 2024 is as follows:

SSC CGL Marking Scheme 2024 - All that you need to know!

- Session 1 of Section 1's Paper 1 comprises 60 questions, totaling 180 marks. Hence, you earn 3 marks for each correct answer.
- Furthermore, Paper 1's Session 1 of Section 2 consists of 70 questions, with a maximum of 210 marks available. Hence, you'll receive 3 marks for each correct answer.
- Paper 2 contains 100 questions with a maximum score of 200 marks. Therefore, for each correct answer, you gain 2 marks.
- Similarly, Paper 3 consists of 100 questions, with a maximum achievable score of 200 marks. Therefore, you earn 2 marks for each correct answer.
- In Section I, Section II, and Module I of Section III of Paper 1, each wrong answer incurs a penalty of 1 mark, while in Paper 2 and Paper 3, the penalty for each wrong answer is 0.50 marks.
