

## SSC CHSL Exam Pattern 2023 - 100 Questions in 60 Minutes

## SSC CHSL Exam Pattern 2023

The SSC CHSL 2023 test will be administered in two stages by the **Staff Selection Commission of India**. Furthermore, only applicants who pass the Tier 1 exam will be eligible for the Tier 2 exam; all other candidates must take the Tier 1 exam.

Final selection will be based on the marks achieved in the SSC CHSL Tier 2 exam and the vacancies announced through the SSC CHSL 2023 Exam. The image below will give you the whole chronology at a single glance.

## SSC CHSL 2024 Exam Pattern - Tier 1

There are two levels in the SSC CHSL Exam. Let's start with comprehending the SSC CHSL Exam Pattern 2024 for Tier 1. Paper covers four different topics. Let's go on to the genuine SSC CHSL Exam Pattern 2024 above anything else.

- Tier 1 is a Computer Based Examination (CBE).
- There are 100 questions in Tier 1, and each question is worth 2 mark.
- The time allotted for these 100 questions is 60 minutes, i.e., 1 hour.
- Moreover, it is also said that the candidates eligible for scribe will be given 80 minutes, i.e., 1 hour and 20 minutes.
- Remember that there will be no negative marking if you do not attempt a question.
- However, in case you select a wrong answer, 0.50 mark or 1/2 of the assigned mark will be deducted for each wrong answer.

Moreover, below, we have provided you with a snippet directly from the official notification of the SSC CHSL Exam Pattern 2024 Tier 1 for your reference.

## SSC CHSL 2024 Exam Pattern - Tier 2

You will be able to take the Tier 2 exam once you pass the Tier 1 exam. Session I and Session II are the two sessions that make up this arrangement. You may see information about the total number of questions, marks, and time permitted for this paper in the graphic below:

- Tier 2 is also a Computer Based Examination (CBE).
- There are **135 questions in Session I**, and each question is worth 3 mark. The time allotted for these 135 questions is 135 minutes, i.e., 2 hours 15 minutes.
- Further, in Session II, there will be a skill test or typing test module held in 3 sections. The time allotted for this session will be 40 minutes.
- Remember that there will be no negative marking if you do not attempt a question.
- However, in case you select a wrong answer, 1/2 of the assigned mark will be deducted for each wrong answer.

## SSC CHSL 2024 Marking Scheme

Now that you've all the information on the SSC CHSL Exam Pattern 2024, let's try to understand the marking scheme. As we are aware, the SSC CHSL exam is conducted in two tiers. To clarify, both tiers comprise objective-type multiple-choice questions. In order to gain a better understanding, take a look below:

- In Tier 1 exam every candidate will be given 2 marks for each answer.
- Moreover, there will be a negative marking of 0.50 marks for every wrong answer.
- Further, for Tier 2 exam each question will be of 3 marks.
- Also, there will be a negative marking of 1 marks for every wrong answer in Tier 2 examination.
- Shall we now proceed forward and take a look at the marks normalization for the SSC CHSL 2024 examination?

## SSC CHSL 2024 Marks Normalization

Let's begin by defining normalisation markings as they actually are. After all, it's a statistical method that takes into consideration any differences in the complexity of the question papers between different exam shifts. It is unfair to compare scores directly between shifts because of the variability in question levels. Normalisation, which equalises the scores and permits a more accurate assessment of candidates, thereby resolves this problem.

Thus, back in 2019, the Staff Selection Commission published the formula in [Notice No.1-1/2018-P&P-I dated 07-02-2019](#), which has been followed ever since. Subsequently, these normalized scores are utilized to determine the final merit and cut-off marks.
