SSC CHSL Exam Pattern 2024 - An Overview

The SSC CHSL 2024 exam will be conducted by the Staff Selection Commission of India in two tiers. In the first tier, all candidates must appear, while the second tier is reserved for those who pass the first one. It's important to understand that Tier 1 of the SSC CHSL serves as a qualifying round, whereas Tier 2 focuses on scoring. Your final selection depends on your performance in the SSC CHSL Tier 2 exam and the number of vacancies announced for the SSC CHSL 2024 Exam i.e., 3712 tentatively. There are two levels in the SSC CHSL Exam. Let's start with comprehending the SSC CHSL Exam Pattern 2024 for Tier 1. Paper covers four different topics. Let's go on to the genuine SSC CHSL Exam Pattern 2024 above anything else.

SSC CHSL Exam Pattern 2024 - 100 Questions in 60 Minutes

- SSC CHSL Tier 1 Exam is an Objective Multiple Choice Question Paper.
- Tier-1 has a total duration of 60 minutes. PWD candidates, on the other hand, have an additional 80 minutes.
- However, each wrong answer carries a 0.50-mark penalty.
- There will be four subjects with 100 questions (objective type), each worth two marks.

SSC CHSL 2024 Exam Pattern - Tier 2

You will be able to take the Tier 2 exam once you pass the Tier 1 exam. Session I and Session II are the two sessions that make up this arrangement. You may see information about the total number of questions, marks, and time permitted for this paper in the graphic below:

- Tier 2 will be held in two sessions, Session 1 and Session 2, on the same day.
- Session I will cover the execution of Sections 1 and 2, as well as Module 1 of Section 3.
- Session 2 will contain the execution of Module 2 of Section 3.
- SSC CHSL Tier 2 will consist of objective-type multiple-choice questions, with the exception of Module 2 in Section 3.
- Further, the questions will be set in English and Hindi, with the exception of Module-2 (English Language and Comprehension module) in Section 2.
- However, in case you select a wrong answer, 1/2 of the assigned mark will be deducted for each wrong answer.

The SSC CHSL Notification 2024 was made public on 8th April 2024 on SSC's new official website. Following the release of the notification, the application form for the same was made active. This year, SSC has released a total of 3712 vacancies. The SSC CHSL application form 2024 will be accessible online till May 7, 2024. Furthermore, the SSC CHSL recruitment 2024 will be for Group C positions such as Lower Divisional Clerk (LDC)/ Junior Secretariat Assistant (JSA) and Data Entry Operators (DEO) for various Ministries, Departments, and Offices of the Government of India, as well as constitutional bodies, statutory bodies, and tribunals.

SSC CHSL 2024 Marking Scheme

Now that you have all of the information on the SSC CHSL Exam Pattern 2024, let's look at the marking structure. To acquire a better idea, look at the following:

- In Tier 1 exam every candidate will be given 2 marks for each answer.
- Moreover, there will be a negative marking of 0.50 marks for every wrong answer.
- Further, for Tier 2 exam each question will be of 3 marks.
- Also, there will be a negative marking of 1 marks for every wrong answer in Tier 2 examination but only in Section 1, Section 2 and Module 1 of Section 3.

Shall we now proceed forward and take a look at the marks normalization for the SSC CHSL 2024 examination?

SSC CHSL 2024 Marks Normalization

Let's begin by defining normalisation markings as they actually are. After all, it's a statistical method that takes into consideration any differences in the complexity of the question papers between different exam shifts. It is unfair to compare scores directly between shifts because of the variability in question levels. Normalisation, which equalises the scores and permits a more accurate assessment of candidates, thereby resolves this problem.

Thus, back in 2019, the Staff Selection Commission published the formula in **Notice No.1-1/2018-P&P-I dated 07-02-2019**, which has been followed ever since. Subsequently, these normalized scores are utilized to determine the final merit and cut-off marks.
