To clarify, both tiers comprise objective-type multiple-choice questions. In order to gain a better understanding, take a look at the table below:

Details	Marking Scheme
SSC CHSL Marking Scheme Tier 1	2 marks each question
SSC CHSL Marking Scheme Tier 1 - Negative Marking	0.50 marks for wrong answers
SSC CHSL Marking Scheme Tier 2	3 marks for each question
SSC CHSL Marking Scheme - Negative Marking	1 marks for wrong answers (only in Section 1, Section 2 and Module 1 of Section 3.)

SSC CHSL Exam Pattern 2024

The Staff Selection Commission of India has outlined the SSC CHSL marking scheme for the 2024 exam, structured across two tiers. It's imperative for candidates to understand that the SSC CHSL Tier 1 examination is obligatory for all applicants, while Tier 2 is exclusive to those who successfully clear Tier 1. Notably, the SSC CHSL marking scheme distinguishes Tier 1 as a qualifying test and Tier 2 as a scoring test. The final selection hinges upon the marks secured in the SSC CHSL Tier 2 exam and the vacancies announced through the SSC CHSL 2024 Exam. For a comprehensive understanding, refer to the image below, providing an overview of the entire chronology in a single glance.

SSC CHSL Exam Pattern Tier 1

The SSC CHSL Examination consists of two tiers. To begin with, let us first understand the SSC CHSL Marking Scheme and other details for Tier 1. There are four subjects in Tier 1, as shown below:

SSC CHSL Marking Scheme 2024 - All You Need to Know

Therefore, a total of 100 questions will be asked in the Tier 1 exam. Above all, let's proceed forward to the actual SSC CHSL Marking Scheme and other details of Tier 2:

- Tier 1 is a Computer Based Examination.
- There are 100 questions in Tier 1, and each question is worth 2 mark.
- The time allotted for these 100 questions is 60 minutes, i.e., 1 hour.
- Moreover, it is also said that the candidates eligible for scribe will be given 80 minutes, i.e., 1 hour and 20 minutes.
- Remember that there will be no negative marking if you do not attempt a question.
- However, in case you select a wrong answer, 0.50 mark or 1/2 of the assigned mark will be deducted for each wrong answer.

SSC CHSL Exam Pattern Tier 2

After clearing the Tier 1 exam, you will be eligible to appear for the Tier 2 exam. However, it consists of **two sessions**, i.e., Session I and Session II. The images below will provide you with details like the number of questions, total marks, and the time allotted for this tier:

- Tier 2 is also a Computer Based Examination.
- There are **135 questions in Session I**, and each question is worth 3 mark. The time allotted for these 135 questions is 135 minutes, i.e., 2 hours 15 minutes.
- Further, in Session II, there will be a skill test or typing test module held in 3 sections. The time provided for this section will be 40 minutes.
- Remember that there will be no negative marking if you do not attempt a question.
- However, in case you select a wrong answer, 1/2 of the assigned mark will be deducted for each wrong answer.

Now that you are completely aware of the SSC CHSL Marking Scheme. We will now give you a brief understanding of the notification.

SSC CHSL Notification 2024

The SSC CHSL Notification 2024 was made public on 8th April 2024 on SSC's new official website. Following the release of the notification, the application form for the same was made active. This year, SSC has released a total of 3712 vacancies. The SSC CHSL application form 2024 will be accessible online till May 7, 2024. Furthermore, the SSC CHSL recruitment 2024 will be for Group C positions such as Lower Divisional Clerk (LDC)/ Junior Secretariat Assistant (JSA) and Data Entry Operators (DEO) for various Ministries, Departments, and Offices of the Government of India, as well as constitutional bodies, statutory bodies, and tribunals.

SSC CHSL Marking Scheme - Marks Normalization

Let's start by clarifying what normalization marks are in reality. It is a statistical technique, after all, that accounts for any variations in the level of difficulty of the question papers across various shifts of the same exam. The level of the questions can vary between shifts, making direct score comparisons unfair. This issue is therefore solved by normalization, which equalizes the scores and enables a more accurate evaluation of applicants.

Thus, back in 2019, the Staff Selection Commission published the formula in [Notice No.1-1/2018-P&P-I dated 07-02-2019](#), which has been followed ever since. Subsequently, these normalized scores are utilized to determine the final merit and cut-off marks.

Well, now that you are aware of the SSC CHSL Marking Scheme, how about we take a look at the important exam dates for the CHSL 2024 examination?

SSC CHSL 2024 Important Dates

According to the [SSC Exam Calendar \(2024-25\)](#), the official SSC CHSL Notification 2024 was supposed to release on 2nd of April, however, it was official released on 8th April 2024. Consequently, SSC made the SSC CHSL application live on the same date. As per the official SSC CHSL notification 2024, Moreover, make sure to complete your application by May 7, 2024. 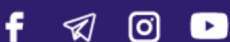
