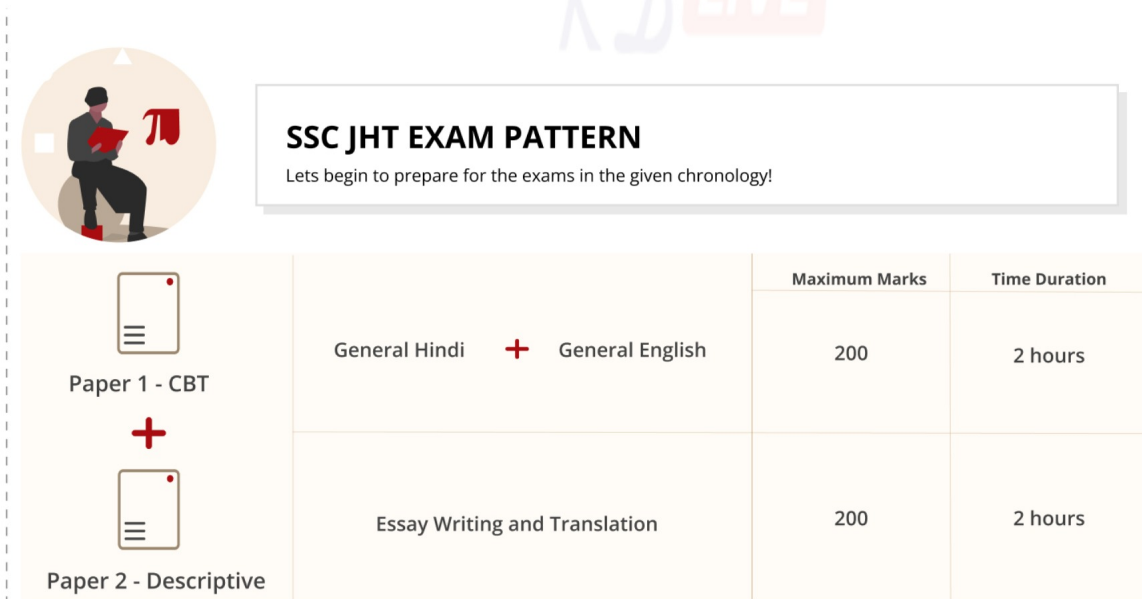

SSC JHT Exam Pattern 2023 - Paper 2

- **Paper Type:** Paper 2 is a pen-and-paper-based test, which means it's conducted offline and consists of descriptive questions.

- **Question Types:** This paper includes 4 questions (2 each) from translation and essay-writing.
- **Translation:** In the translation section, you will be tasked with translating one Hindi passage into English and one English passage into Hindi.
- **Essay Writing:** For the essay writing part, you will need to compose one essay in Hindi and another in English.
- **Duration:** You will have a cumulative duration of 2 hours to complete Paper 2. For candidates with disabilities (PWD), the duration is extended to 2 hours and 40 minutes.

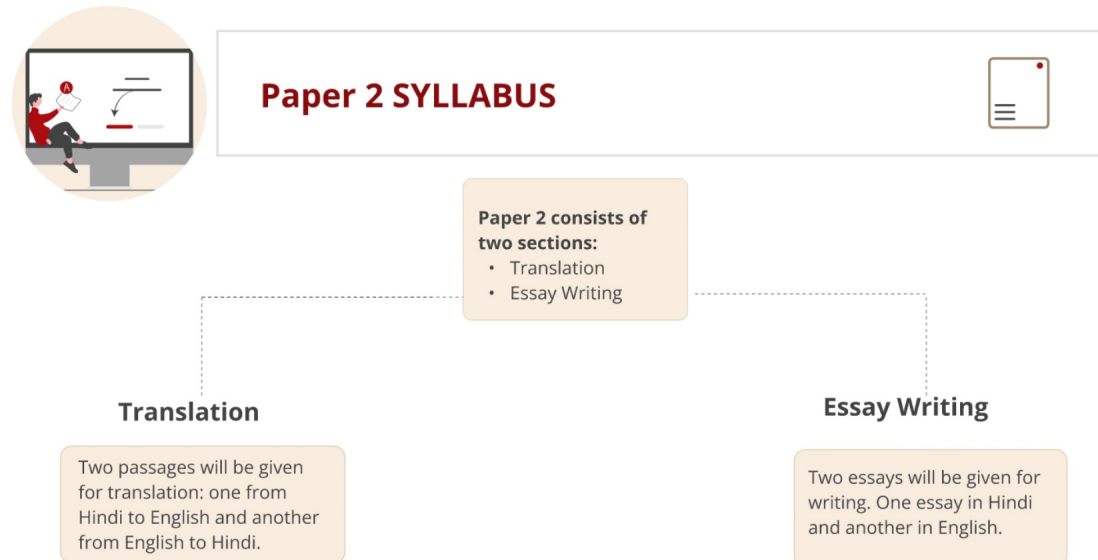

Consequently, the subjects covered in the Translation and Essay Examination encompass:

- Translating paragraphs from Hindi to English.
- Translating paragraphs from English to Hindi.
- Composing an essay in English
- Composing an essay in Hindi

SSC JHT 2023 Marking Scheme

The marking scheme for the SSC JHT (Staff Selection Commission Junior Hindi Translator) exam varies between Paper 1 and Paper 2. Moreover, it's important to note that the final selection for SSC JHT is based on your combined performance in Paper 1 and Paper 2. The exact qualifying marks may vary from year to year, so it's crucial to stay updated with the official SSC notifications for the most accurate information regarding the marking scheme and qualifying criteria.

Now let's move on to the marking scheme for the SSC JHT exam in 2023.

- Paper 1 consists of a total of 200 multiple-choice questions (MCQs), with an equal split of 100 questions in General English and 100 questions in General Hindi.
- In Paper 1, each question carries a value of one mark, and for each incorrect response, 0.25 marks are deducted as a penalty.
- Both Paper 1 and Paper 2 have a maximum achievable score of 200 marks. Notably, Paper 2 does not impose any negative marking for incorrect answers.
