Along with the details on SSC MTS Exam Pattern 2024, this blog aims to provide you with a comprehensive timeline. But before that let us first dive into the details of SSC MTS Computer Based Exam 2024.

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SSC MTS Exam Pattern 2024 - Computer Based Exam

To begin with, the SSC MTS Exam Pattern 2024 consists of two stages: a Computer Based Exam (CBE) and a Physical Efficiency Test or Physical Standard Test, applicable only for those aspiring to become a havaldar in CBIN or CBN. The Computer Based Exam (CBE) is further divided into two sessions, both of which are obligatory. Following the CBE, there is a PET/PST (for havaldars only), but for now, our focus is solely on the CBE.

The Computer Based Examination (CBE) is structured as follows:

- Session 1 comprises 40 questions, each carrying 3 marks.
- Session 2 consists of 50 questions, each carrying 3 marks.
- The time allocated for each session is 45 minutes.
- Notably, there is no negative marking in session 1.
- However, in session 2, there is a deduction of 1 mark for every incorrect answer. It is important to note that there is no negative marking if a question is left unanswered.
- If you are a candidate eligible for scribe, you will be granted 60 minutes per session for solving questions in both sessions, instead of the standard 45 minutes.

We will elaborate on each subject's topics in the SSC MTS Syllabus 2024 segment below. However, let's progress to the next step in the exam journey- PET or PST.

SSC MTS 2024 Physical Standard Test/ Physical Endurance Test

Secondly, the Physical Standard Test (PST) or the Physical Endurance Test (PET) plays a crucial role. After completing

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- Height
- Chest
- Weight

These criteria differ for men and women. Below, we've provided a table to illustrate the specific measurements for height, chest, and weight required for PST.

Details	Male	Female
Height(in cm)	157.5	152
Unexpanded Chest (in cm)	81	-
Expanded Chest (in cm)	86	-
Weight (in kg)	-	48 (relaxable by 2 Kg in the case of Garhwalis, Assamese, Gorkhas and members of Schedule Tribes)

Now that you have a clear understanding of the physical standards you need to meet, let's proceed to explore the components of the Physical Efficiency Test (PET).

Physical Efficiency Test

As the name implies, this test assesses the fitness levels of candidates who have successfully cleared the Computer Based Examination and qualified for the PST. Let's delve into the details:

Firstly, for Male Candidates, the PET includes the following test:

- Running 1600 meters in 15 minutes

Secondly, for Female Candidates, the PET includes the following test:

- Running 1 kilometer in 20 minutes

Additionally, if you are 12 weeks pregnant during the PET test, you will be temporarily declared unfit for the examination. However, your vacancy will be secured, and you will be re-examined six weeks after delivery, or earlier if you provide a medical certificate of fitness from a registered medical professional.

If you are a candidate with specified disabilities. then, you may be exempted from the Physical Efficiency Test. Furthermore, please take note of the following:

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S. No.	Suitable category for benchmark disability for post of Havaladar	Exemption in PET/PST
1.	HH	No exemption
2.	OA	No exemption
3.	OL	May be exempted from Walking
4.	OAL	May be exempted from Walking
5.	LC	May be exempted from Walking
6.	AAV	No exemption However. If due to acid attack the candidates suffer from orthopaedic disability i.e. OA, OL, OAL, then above exemption for OA , OL and OAL will apply
7.	MD involving above categories	Above exemption for HH ,OA , OL , OAL , LC , and AAV will apply

Abbreviations used: HH = Hard of Hearing, OA= One Arm, OL= One Leg, OAL= One Arm & One Leg, LC= Leprosy Cured, AAV = Acid Attack Victim, MD = Multiple Disabilities.

The Staff Selection Commission holds exams for Multi Tasking Staff & Havaladar Recruitment, with many applicants preparing for their selection. The SSC has released the official notification for the same on 27th June 2024. However, as per the SSC Calendar 2024-24, it was expected to be released on 7th June 2024. As per the official notification, a total of 8326, vacancies have been released for both MTS and Havaladar. Out of these vacancies, 4887 are for the Mult-Tasking Staff and 3439 are for Havaladar in CBIC and CBN. Further, the application process has started from 27th June 2024 and will end on 31st July 2024. Conducted by the Staff Selection Commission (SSC), the SSC MTS Exam 2024 aims to recruit individuals for Group 'C' non-gazetted, non-ministerial positions.

Session I

- Numerical and Mathematical Ability
- Reasoning Ability and Problem Solving

Key facts about Session I:

- 20 questions per subject
- Each question carries 3 marks
- No negative marking

Session II

Following the SSC MTS Exam Pattern 2024, Session 2 is also mandatory. The subjects in this session are:

- General Awareness
- English Language and Comprehension

Key facts about Session 2:

- 25 questions per subject
- Each question is worth 3 marks
- Negative marking of one mark for each wrong answer; no negative marking for unattempted questions

SSC MTS 2024 Marking Scheme

As we know, the SSC MTS recruitment examination in 2024 consists of two sessions, both featuring objective multiple-choice questions. These questions will be presented in Hindi, English, or in 13 regional languages for Paper 2 of Session 1 and Paper 1 of Session 2. Session 1 papers have no negative marking, while Session 2 papers have a negative marking of one mark. Moreover, each question is for 3 marks.

Now that we have clarified the SSC MTS marking scheme, let's move on to understanding marks normalization for the SSC MTS examination 2024.

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SSC MTS 2024 Marks Normalization

How about we begin with understanding what marks normalization is? Well, it is a statistical method that accounts for any disparities in the difficulty levels of question papers across multiple shifts of the same exam. Since different shifts can have varying levels of complexity in their questions, direct score comparison might not be equitable. Thus, normalization addresses this issue by equalizing the scores, enabling a more just evaluation of candidates.

In addition, SSC published the formula that will be followed in

. Subsequently, these normalized scores are utilized to determine the final merit and cut off marks.
