Remember, there is only one Tier in SSC MTS examination, which is followed by PET and PST, but only for the post of Havaldar. So, let's understand the marking scheme with the help of some pointers:

- In the Computer Based Examination (CBE) for Session-I of Paper 1, there will be no negative marking.
- For Session-II of Paper 1, however, each incorrect answer will result in a deduction of 1 mark. In Session-I, candidates will be awarded 3 marks for each correct answer without any penalty for wrong answers.
- Conversely, in Session-II, candidates will receive 3 marks for correct answers but will incur a deduction of 1 mark for each incorrect response. Candidates need to strategize accordingly and weigh their choices carefully during both sessions to maximize their scores effectively.

SSC MTS Exam Pattern 2024

As per the SSC MTS Exam Pattern 2024, candidates will undergo a Computer-Based Test featuring two mandatory sessions: Session I and Session II. Skipping any of these sessions will lead to disqualification. The initial paper (Paper-I) will include multiple-choice questions with objective answers. While Session-I won't impose negative marking, Session-II will deduct one mark for each incorrect response. Marks will be normalized. Questions will be available in English, Hindi, and 13 other languages.

SSC MTS Exam Pattern 2024 Paper I

The SSC MTS Paper-I Exam follows an online multiple-choice format covering sections like Reasoning, English Language, Numerical Aptitude, and General Awareness, totaling 90 questions and 270 marks. This updated pattern introduced alongside the SSC MTS 2024 Notification includes two compulsory sessions: Session-I and Session-II. Further, refer to the table below for a better understanding:

SSC MTS Exam Pattern 2024 Havaldar PET & PST

Applicants for the SSC Havaldar position are required to undergo the Physical Efficiency Test (PET) and Physical Standard Test (PST) following their successful completion of the SSC MTS Tier-1 Exam. The criteria for PET for the Havaldar position in CBIC and CBN, as detailed in the SSC MTS Notification 2024, are as follows:

Particulars	Male	Female
Walking	1600 meters in 15 minutes	1 km in 20 minutes

The PST criteria for the Havaldar job in CBIC and CBN, as specified in the SSC MTS Notification 2024, are as follows:

Particulars	Male	Female
Height	157.5 cms (relaxable by 5 Cms in the case of Garhwalis, Assamese, Gorkhas and members of Scheduled Tribes)	152 cms (relaxable by 2.5 Cms in the case of Garhwalis, Assamese, Gorkhas and members of Schedule Tribes)
Chest	76 cms (unexpanded) Minimum expansion: 5 cms	-
Weight	-	48 kg (relaxable by 2 Kg in the case of Garhwalis, Assamese, Gorkhas and members of Schedule Tribes)
