

- 2. Candidates will have a time limit of 60 minutes (1 hour) for this exam, with 80 minutes provided to eligible candidates who require scribes.
- 3. The exam consists of four sections, and each section must be completed.
- 4. Each question carries a value of two marks.
- 5. For every incorrect answer, a penalty of 0.50 marks is deducted as a negative marking.
- 6. In total, you are required to answer 100 questions, with a maximum score of 200 marks available.

- Lastly, the SSC Selection Post computer-based exam will consist of Objective Type Multiple Choice questions.


SSC Selection Post 2023 Marks Normalization



Consequently, the SSC Selection Post Notification 2023 stated that the marks scored by candidates in Computer Based Examination will be normalized by using the formula published by the Commission through Notice No: 1-1/2018-P&P-I dated 07-02-2019. Further, these normalized scores help calculate your final merit and cut-off marks.


