











SSC Stenographer Shorthand Skill Test

After the Computer Based Test, there will be a shorthand skill test. We have divided all the important pointers into bullet points to make their comprehension easy.

- Candidates like you, who qualify in Level 1 will move on to the Skill Test.
- For Stenographer Grade C, you'll have a 10-minute dictation in English/Hindi at 100 words per minute.
- For Stenographer Grade D, it's a 10-minute dictation in English/Hindi at 80 words per minute.
- The dictation will be done on a computer.
- If you choose the test in Hindi, you'll need to learn English Stenography (and vice versa) after being appointed.
- The Skill Test will be held at the Commission's Regional/Sub-Regional Offices.


SSC Stenographer Marks Normalization 2023
