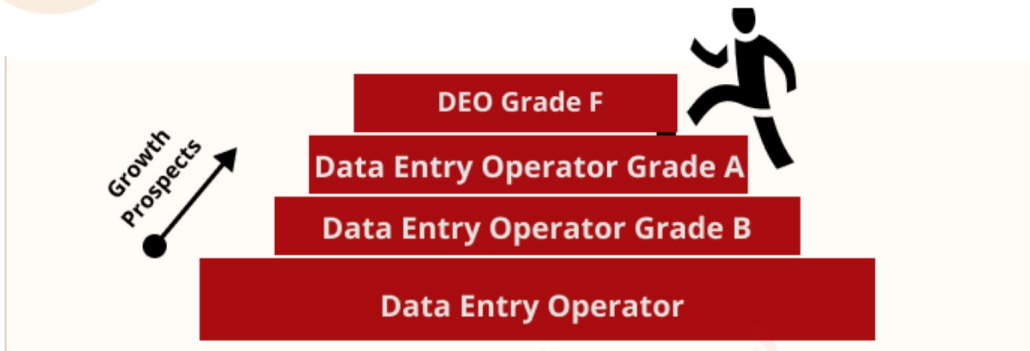

## Postal Assistant or Sorting Assistant

When it comes to the career prospects of Postal Assistants (PAs) or Sorting Assistants (SAs), it's fair to say they have a much better scope for growth compared to LDCs or DEOs. If you're a PA or SA, you can apply and take the departmental exam for the post of Postmaster Grade I after completing 5 years of service. Even if you choose not to take these departmental exams, you'll automatically be promoted to higher posts after a decade of service, following the MACP rules.
