## What is biodiversity? Why do we need to protect it?

#### How and When did it start?

In the year 2000, the UN General Assembly adopted 22nd May as IDB to commemorate the adoption of the text of the Convention on 22 May 1992 by the Nairobi Final Act of the Conference for the Adoption of the Agreed Text of the Convention on Biological Diversity.

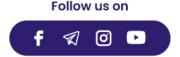
## What is the theme for the year 2023?
