Answers and Solutions

Q:1 The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. **Derozio**.

In 1827, Accademic Association was organised by Derozio at Maniktala, Calcutta.

'Athenaeum' was the mouth-piece of this organisation.

Q:2 The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e **Surendranath Banerjee**.

The Indian National Association was one of the first and specified nationalist organization established by **Surendranath Banerjee** and **Ananda Mohan Bose** in 1876.

The aim of this association was to promote, by every legitimate means, the political, intellectual and material advancement of the people.

The association attracted many educated Indians and civil leaders from all parts of the country.

Q:3 The correct answer is **Option 1** i.e. **1917**.

On 8 May 1917 in Adyar, Madras, a multiethnic group of women established the Women's Indian Association (WIA).

The WIA was one of the first organizations to boldly connect Indian women's social and sexual subjugation with patriarchy, poverty, and political disenfranchisement.

Q:4 The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. **1838**.

Landholders' Society was established in 1838 in Calcutta by Radhakanta Dev, Dwarkanath Tagore and Prasanna Kumar Tagore.

Radhakanta Dev was the President of this organisation.

Q:5 The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. **Madam Cama**.

Parsi women Madam Vikaji Rustanji Cama or Madam Cama established 'Free India Society' in London.

It was a political organization of Indian students in England, committed to obtaining the independence of India from British rule.

Q:6 The correct answer is **Option 2** i.e. **Mary Carpenter**.

The National Indian Association was formed by Mary Carpenter.

It was formed in 1870 in Bristol.

The National Indian Association's first aim was to improve education for Indian women.

She was an English educational and social reformer who came to India in 1866.

Q:7 The correct answer is **Option 1** i.e. **Ananda Mohan Bose**.

Indian National Association was the first declared Nationalist Organization founded in by Surendranath Banerjee and Anand Mohan Bose in 1876.

Ananda Mohan Bose was the secretary of this association.

The association was supported mainly by younger professional men among the Bengali intelligentsia.

It merged in INC in 1885.

Q:8 The correct answer is **Option 2** i.e **George Thomson and Pyarichand Mitra became the President and Secretary, respectively.**

British Indian Association was created after amalgamating the "Landholders Society" and "British India Society" on 31 October 1851.

This was the first political organization that brought the Indians together.

The President of the first committee of this organization was Raja Radhakanta Deb, while Debendranath Tagore was its secretary

In the wake of the upcoming charter act (of 1853) in 1852, this organization sent a delegation to England, pleading for separation of Judiciary with executive, higher posts and pays for Indians, abolition of salt duty and inclusion of Indians in the legislative councils. But all expectations were negated by the Charter Act of 1853.

Q:9 The correct answer is **Option 1** i.e **S.N Halder.**

The Jamshedpur Labour Association was founded in **1920 by S.N Halder**. It was started with the workers of the TATA Steel Industry at Jamshedpur and later renamed as the Tata Workers Union in 1938.

The association continued its existence and remained the principal and most representative workers' organization having control over all sections of the workers.

Q:10 The correct answer is **Option 1** i.e **Mahatma Gandhi.**

Mahatma Gandhi along with Anasuya Sarabhai and Shankerlal Banker founded the Ahmadabad textile labour association in 1918.

This association one of the oldest labour associations in India and the first meeting was held on the banks of river Sabarmati where ten thousand labours were present.

Anasuya Sarabhai was the first women trade union leader in India and as a founder of this association, she is the pioneer of labour movement.
