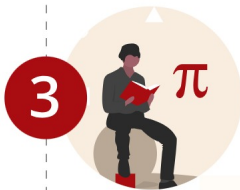

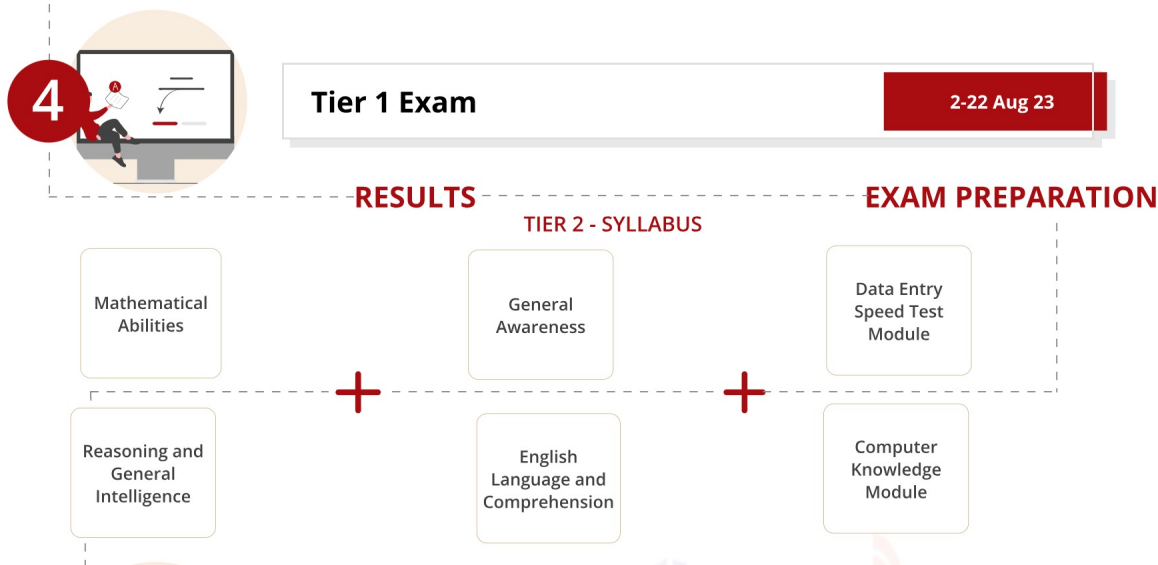

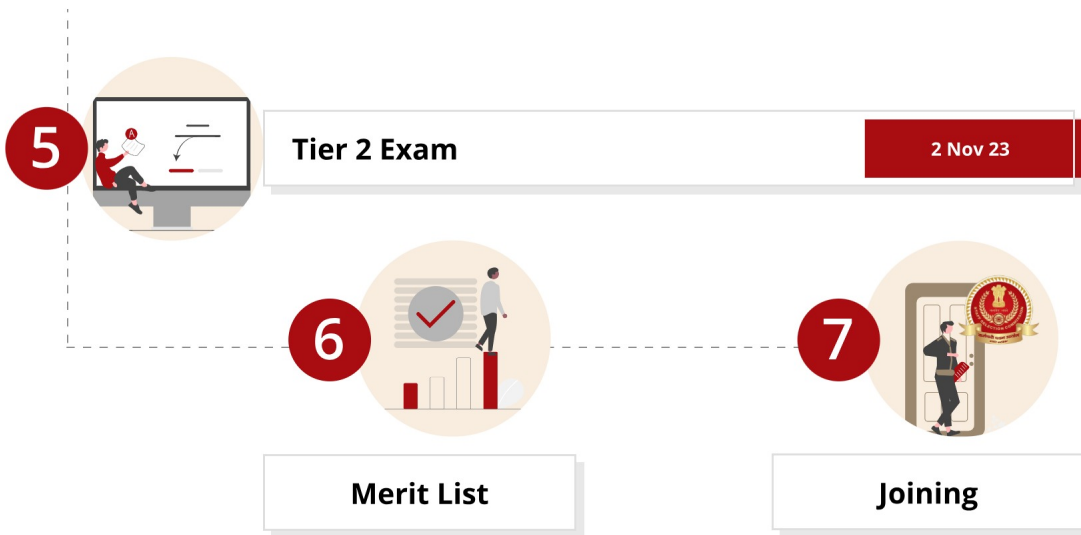

Since we have learned about the process, let's now discuss about the SSC CHSL Examinations. The SSC CHSL Exam stands for Staff Selection Commission Combined Higher Secondary Level Exam. The Staff Selection Commission released the official SSC CHSL Notification 2023 on 9th May 2023. If you want to download the [SSC CHSL Official Notification 2023](#), click on the embedded link.

Now that you are fully aware of your exam journey, how about we proceed towards decoding the SSC CHSL Notification 2023? It is crucial for you to not only understand its table of contents but also each of them in detail. However, the first and foremost step is the bifurcation of the SSC CHSL Notification 2023 in order of its importance. Thus, below we have laid down the order in which we will proceed in this blog:

In addition, the main aim of this examination is to recruit candidates for various positions such as Lower Divisional Clerk (LDC)/ Junior Secretariat Assistant, Data Entry Operator (DEO), Postal Assistant (PA), Sorting Assistant (SA), and Court Clerk in government ministries and departments. The registrations for which started on 9th May 2023 and applicants could submit their applications till 8th June 2023.

SSC CHSL 2023 Eligibility

Furthermore, the next step to prepare for the examination is to know the eligibility criteria. Thus, there are three main eligibility criteria which are listed below:

1. **Nationality:** Must be a citizen of India, or a subject of Nepal or Bhutan or a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania, Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India.
2. **Age Limit** (As on 01-08-2023): Must be between the age group of 18 years and 27 years.
3. **Educational Qualification** (As on 01-08-2023): Must have appeared in 12th standard or an equivalent examination from a recognized Board or University.

SSC CHSL 2023 Vacancy

Moreover, an important factor for consideration is the number of vacancies. As per the official SSC CHSL Notification 2023, a total of 1600 tentative vacancies have been released. The craze for government jobs in India is no secret. Thus, every year a rush of thousands of applicants is witnessed in exams conducted by the Staff Selection Commission of India. The list of posts under the CHSL recruitment exam 2023 is provided below in bullet points:

- Data Entry Operator (DEO)
- Data Entry Operator (DEO), Grade A
- Sorting Assistant (SA)
- Postal Assistant (PA)
- Lower Divisional Clerk (LDC)
- Junior Secretariat Assistant (JSA)

SSC CHSL Post and Salary 2023

Since it is a known fact that everyone's ultimate motive is to earn money, how about learning the detailed salary criteria mentioned in the SSC CHSL Notification 2023? The pay scale after clearing SSC CHSL 2023 exam will vary as per the post, the candidate has qualified for. The variation can be sub-categorized as:

- **Data Entry Operator (DEO):** Pay Level - 4 (Rs. 25,500 - 81,100) and Level - 5 (Rs. 29,200 - 92,300)
- **Data Entry Operator (DEO), Grade A:** Pay Level - 4 (Rs. 25,500 - 81,100)
- **Lower Divisional Clerk (LDC):** Pay Level - 2 (Rs. 19,900 - 63,200)
- **Junior Secretariat Assistant (JSA):** Pay Level - 2 (Rs. 19,900 - 63,200)

SSC CHSL Exam Pattern 2023

The CHSL Tier-1 Examination consists of the objective type-multiple choice questions only. This tier consists of a negative marking of 0.5 marks for each wrong answer. Thus, you should only mark answers with utmost certainty.

However, you must note that Session I includes Section I, Section II, and Module I of Section III. Session II, thus followed includes Module II of Section III as reflected below in the image:

The reasons are obvious, for instance, it helps you correctly direct your study efforts. Are you wondering how? See, only if you know the syllabus in detail, you will be able to make better decisions for your resource selection and time management. Moreover, all these aspects collectively, will make your preparation approach more organised and focused.

We have listed down the subjects for you below:

- General Intelligence and Reasoning
- General Awareness
- Quantitative Aptitude
- English Comprehension

SSC CHSL Marking Scheme 2023

We have 100 questions in Tier 1, and each subject consists of 25 questions with a weighted average of 50 marks, as is evident from our exam pattern section. However, you must keep in mind that there is a 0.5 mark deduction for each incorrect response.

In Tier 2, there is a negative marking of 1 mark for each incorrect answer in Section - I, Section II and Module - I of Section - III.

Additionally, all of the questions will be available in both Hindi and English.

SSC CHSL Marks Normalization 2023

Let's start by clarifying what normalization marks are in reality. It is a statistical technique, after all, that accounts for any variations in the level of difficulty of the question papers across various shifts of the same exam. The level of the questions can vary between shifts, making direct score comparisons unfair. This issue is therefore solved by normalization, which equalizes the scores and enables a more accurate evaluation of applicants.

Thus, back in 2019, the Staff Selection Commission published the formula in [Notice No.1-1/2018-P&P-I dated 07-02-2019](#), which has been followed ever since. Subsequently, these normalized scores are utilized to determine the final merit and cut-off marks.

On 9th May 2023, the official notification for the SSC CHSL Exam was released. Thereon, the application link was updated and was closed after 8th June 2023. All the eligible and interested candidates can fill up the [application form](#) by clicking on the embedded link before the last date of application. Moreover, the procedure for filling of online applications consists of two parts i.e., one-time registration and filling out an online application for the exam. Also, you must make sure to fill up all the necessary details accurately to avoid any hustle later.

Application Fees for SSC CHSL 2023

Remember that the application fees for SSC CHSL 2023 are to be paid only through SBI either in the form of Challan or via other banks' credit/debit cards, or through SBI Net Banking. The fees paid are a non-refundable amount. The fee structure for the aspiring candidates is as follows:

- For SC/ST/Women/Ex-Servicemen: No fees
- For General/OBC, the application fee is Rs. 100/-

SSC CHSL Apply Online - Step by Step Approach

Thereafter, to access the SSC CHSL Notification 2023 and Application Link, follow these steps:

- Visit the official SSC website.
- Further, sign up to create your login credentials if you have not yet created your Unique id and password.
- Once you are through that step, login to fill up the SSC CHSL 2023 form by clicking on apply button.
- Thereafter, fill up all your details and upload all your necessary documents like your recent photo and signature.
- If you are eligible for an application fee, then pay the amount and submit it.
- Once you are done with the process, do not forget to take a printout of your application form for future reference.

SSC CHSL 2023 Admit Card and Exam Center

The release date announced for the examination was 21st July 2023. However, do not forget that the admit card will be available region-wise on the respective official regional websites.
