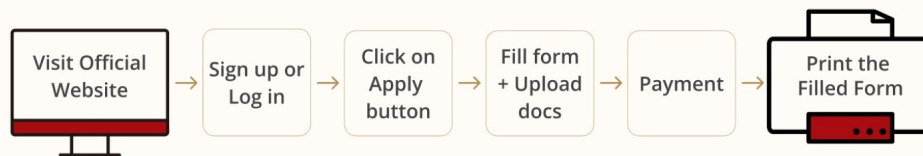

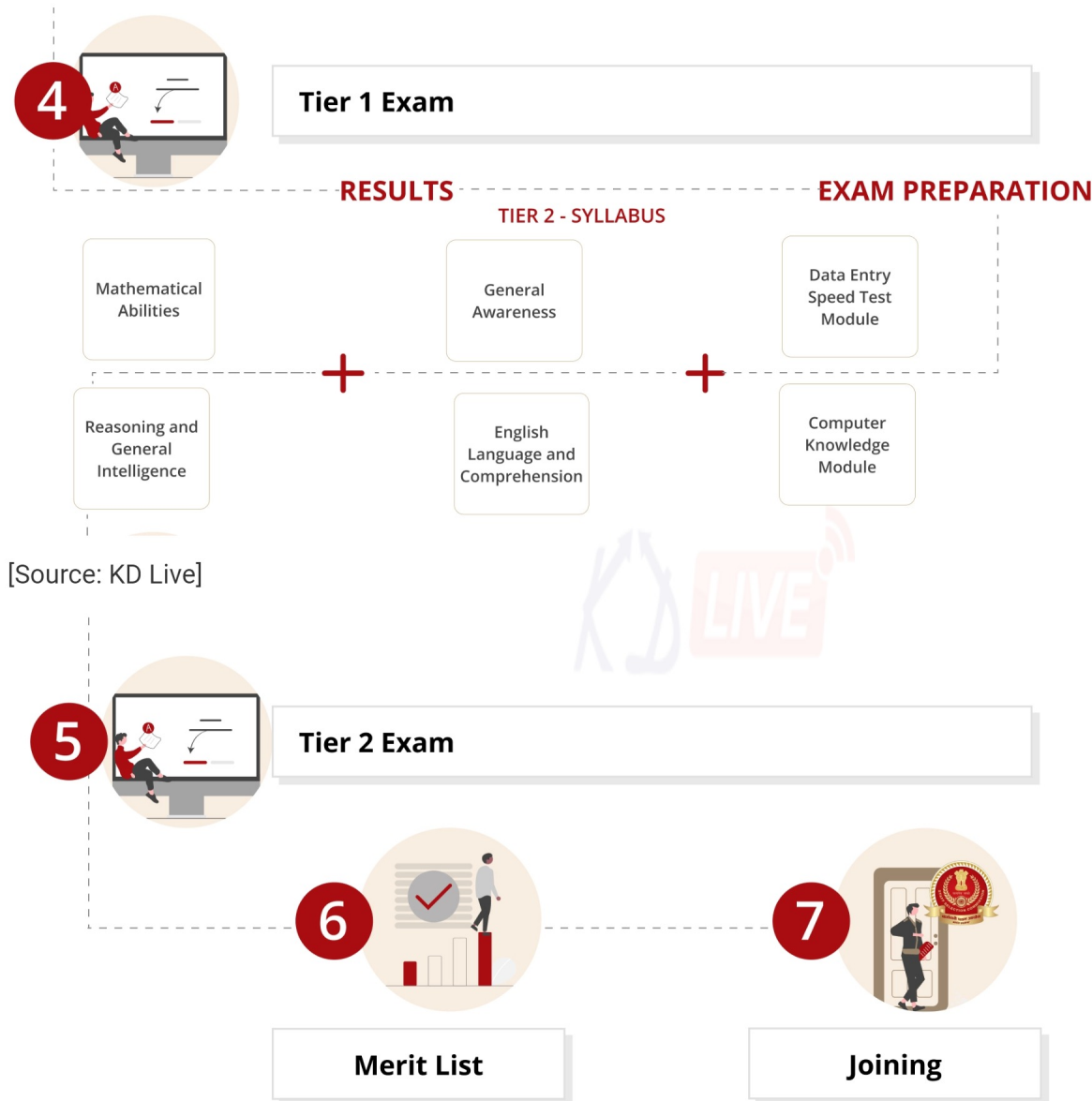


TIER 1 - SYLLABUS

SSC CHSL Eligibility

An essential step in readying yourself for the examination involves a comprehensive understanding of the eligibility criteria. Thus, SSC CHSL eligibility criteria constitute three crucial aspects, outlined as follows:

1. **Nationality:** Applicants must hold Indian citizenship, or they can be subjects of Nepal or Bhutan. Alternatively, individuals of Indian origin who have migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries such as Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania, Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia, and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India are also eligible.
2. **Age Limit:** Applicants must fall within the age bracket of 18 to 27 years to meet the eligibility criteria.
3. **Educational Qualification:** Candidates must have completed the 12th standard or its equivalent from a recognized Board.

SSC CHSL Posts

- Data Entry Operator (DEO)
- Data Entry Operator (DEO), Grade A
- Lower Divisional Clerk (LDC)
- Junior Secretariat Assistant (JSA)

SSC CHSL Tier I Exam Pattern

Scheme of Tier-I Examination:

Tier	Part	Subject (Not in sequence)	Number of Questions/ Maximum Marks	Time Duration (For all four Parts)
I	I	English Language (Basic Knowledge)	25/ 50	60 Minutes (80 Minutes for candidates eligible for scribe as per Para-7.1, 7.2 and 7.3)

	III	Quantitative Aptitude (Basic Arithmetic Skill)	25/ 50	
	IV	General Awareness	25/ 50

- The CHSL Tier-1 Examination consists of the objective type-multiple choice questions only.
- Additionally, the Tier I examination encompasses five subjects.
- Furthermore, there are 25 questions in each of the five subjects, and every question in each subject is worth 2 marks.
- Lastly, Tier I will last for a duration of 60 minutes.

SSC CHSL Tier II Exam Pattern

- Tier 2, like Tier 1, is conducted as a Computer Based Examination (CBE).
- Session I comprises 135 questions, each valued at 3 marks. The time allocated for answering these 135 questions is 135 minutes, equivalent to 2 hours and 15 minutes.
- Session II is dedicated to a skill test or typing test, divided into three sections. The time allotted for this session is 40 minutes.

SSC CHSL Marks Normalization

Let's begin by elucidating the concept of normalization marks. Essentially, it is a statistical technique designed to address variations in the difficulty levels of question papers across different shifts of the same examination. Since the complexity of questions may differ between shifts, comparing raw scores directly becomes inequitable. Normalization resolves this issue by equalizing scores, and ensuring a fair and precise evaluation of candidates.

In 2019, the Staff Selection Commission introduced a formula, detailed in Notice No.1-1/2018-P&P-I dated 07-02-2019, which has since been consistently applied. These normalized scores play a pivotal role in determining the final merit and cut-off marks for candidates.

Application Fees for SSC CHSL

Keep in mind that the application fees for SSC CHSL must be paid exclusively through SBI, either using a Challan or via credit/debit cards from other banks or SBI Net Banking. Moreover, the fees once paid are non-refundable. The fee schedule for candidates is outlined as follows:

- SC/ST/Women/Ex-Servicemen: No fees
- General/OBC: Application fee of Rs. 100/- applies.
