#### SSC CHSL Recruitment 2024 - Out for 3712 Vacancies

The subsequent step in preparing for the examination involves understanding the eligibility criteria. Hence, there are three primary eligibility criteria outlined below:

- Nationality: Must be a citizen of India, or a subject of Nepal or Bhutan, or a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania, Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia, and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India.
- Age Limit: Must fall within the age range of 18 years and 27 years as on 01.08.2024.
- Essential Educational Qualification: Must have appeared in the 12th standard or an equivalent examination from a recognized Board or University as on 01.08.2024.



# SSC CHSL Recruitment 2024 - Exam Pattern and Marking Scheme

As per the official notification and past trends, there are two tiers in the SSC CHSL recruitment 2024 process. The Tier-1 Examination of CHSL comprises only objective type multiple-choice questions. In this tier, there is a penalty of 0.50 marks for each incorrect answer, emphasizing the importance of marking responses only when certain about them.

Since the previous year, CHSL Tier-2 has been organized in two separate sessions, namely Session I and Session II, both taking place on the same date. It is important to observe that Session I comprises Section I, Section II, and Section III. Subsequently, Session II includes Module II of Section III, as illustrated in the image below:

The mark per question has been precisely described in the above snippet which is taken from the SSC CHSL Notification 2024 itself. Moreover, for each incorrect answer, there will be negative marking of 1 mark for each wrong answer in Section-I, Section-II and Module-I of Section-III.
