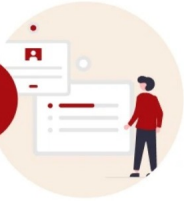

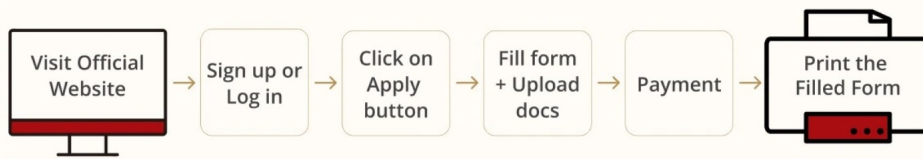

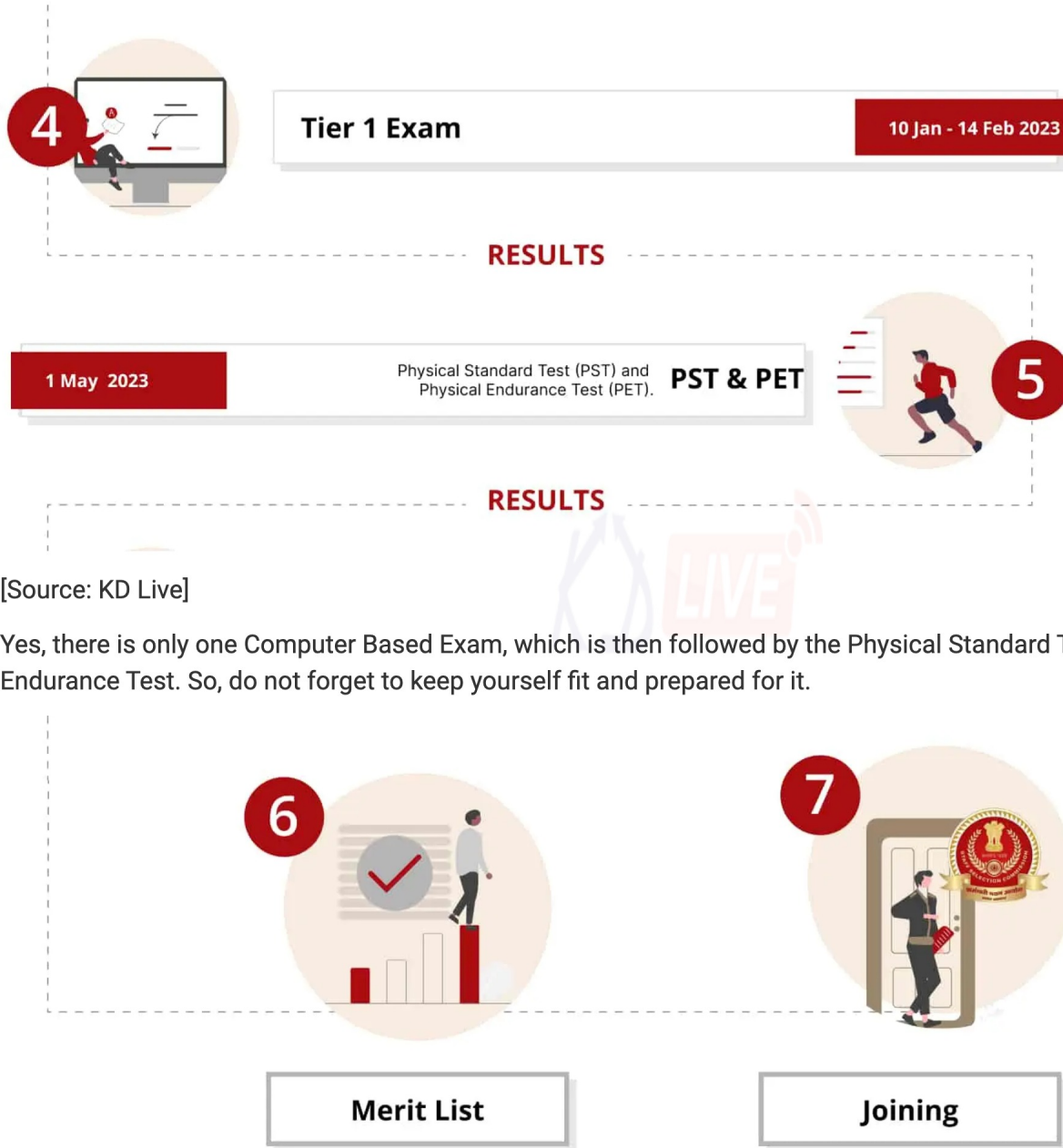

To start with, the most crucial step to put forward before starting the preparations for your exam is to be aware of the eligibility criteria. The main categories of the eligibility criteria for the GD Constable include:

- **Nationality/Citizenship:** You must be either a citizen of India or a subject of Nepal or Bhutan
- **Age Limit:** You must not be less than 18 years old and should not be more than 23 years old as on 01.01.2023
- **Education Qualification:** You must have passed the 10th exam as on 01.01.2023 in order to be eligible for the GD Constable examination.

Another important factor of consideration for such government exams is the number of vacancies for that year. Further, the SSC had released the tentative number of vacancies under various forces like BSF, CISF, AR etc. Moreover, for those preparing for the exam of GD Constable, it is important to know what BSF, CSIF, and ITBP actually stand for:

- BSF stands for **Border Security Force**.
- CRPF stands for **Central Industrial Security Force**.
- ITBP stands for **Indo-Tibetan Border Police**.

## SSC GD Constable 2023 Posts and Salaries

Next, we'll discuss the recruitment process involved in the GD Constable exam 2023. This exam caters to the recruitment of General Duty Constable posts in organizations like the Border Security Force (BSF), Central Industrial Security Force (CRPF), Indo-Tibetan Border Police (ITBP), etc. You can further refer to the first infographic, it provides all the posts that you will be eligible for after clearing the GD Constable examination 2023.

Furthermore, it is a fact that everyone's ultimate goal of a successful career is to earn money in order to lead a comfortable life. So, it is natural for you to be curious about the pay scale. The pay scale of a person is determined by the post they hold. The variation in the pay scale is as follows:

- **Sepoy in NCB:** The post of Sepoy carries a pay scale of Pay Level-1 (Rs.18,000 to 56,900)
- **All other posts** carry a pay scale of Pay Level-3 (Rs. 21,700-69,100)

## SSC GD Constable 2023 Exam Pattern

In addition, it is important to learn about the exam pattern which is to be followed. The GD Constable recruitment exam consists of the Computer Based Exam (CBE), Physical Efficiency Test, Physical Standard Test, Medical Examination, and Document verification. Further, the table below provides the structure and marking scheme for the Computer Based Exam:

## SSC GD Constable 2023 Syllabus

Thereafter, you need to learn about the syllabus so that you can plan your schedule accordingly. Knowing your syllabus helps you in time management so that you can prepare yourselves for the examination timely. There are four main subjects that come under the Computer Based Examination:

- General Intelligence and Reasoning
- General Knowledge and General Awareness
- Elementary Mathematics
- English/ Hindi

## SSC GD Constable 2023 Marking Scheme

There will be 80 questions in total, worth a maximum marks of 160. Further, CBE takes up a total of 60 minutes. For each incorrect response, **0.50 marks will be deducted** from the final score. The level of the questions will be of 10th grade/high school level.

Further, the National Cadet Corps (NCC) certificate holders will be given bonus marks in the CBE which will be added to the normalized scores of such candidates. Talking about normalized scores, let us explain you the marks normalization process followed by SSC in the GD Constable recruitment exam.

## SSC GD Constable 2023 Marks Normalization

How about we start by defining what the normalization of marks is? It is a statistical technique that takes into account any differences in the degree of difficulty of the question papers across different shifts of the same exam. Direct score comparison may not be fair because the complexity of the questions between shifts can change. Thus, normalization resolves this problem by bringing the scores into parity, allowing for a more fair assessment of candidates.

Also, back in 2019, SSC published the formula, as elaborated in [Notice No.1-1/2018-P&P-I dated 07-02-2019](#), that will be followed in the normalization of marks. Subsequently, these normalized scores are utilized to determine the final merit and cut-off marks.

## SSC GD Constable 2023 Important Dates

Further, it is crucial that you are aware of the important dates regarding the examination so that you can prepare accordingly. According to the official SSC GD Constable Notification 2023, the submission of the online application form took place from 27th October to 30th November 2022. Further, the last date and time for receipt of online application was 30th November, 2022 at 11 pm. Moreover, the candidates were able to make online payments by 1st December 2022. From that point onward, the exams for the same took place in January 2023. Furthermore, provided below is a snip of the official notification for your reference.

- Further, sign up or create your login credentials, if you have not created your Unique id and password yet.
- Once you are through that step, login to fill up the SSC GD form by clicking on the apply button.
- Thereafter, fill up all your details and upload all your necessary documents like your recent photo and signature.
- If you are eligible for the payment then pay the amount and submit it.

Once you have completed the process, remember to take a print out of your application form for future reference.

Next, you should be filled in regarding the application fees to be paid in order to appear in the exam. The fees payable for the recruitment examination of the SSC GD Constable is Rs 100/- (Hundred Rupees only). However, there are some people who are exempted from the fee payment. These include women, scheduled caste, scheduled tribe and ex-servicemen. Further, the details of the fee payment are as follows:

- You can pay fees through BHIM UPI, Net Banking, Mastercard, etc.
- Moreover, the last date for the payment of online fees was 1st December 2022.
- Further, once you have paid the fees, it is non-refundable under any circumstances.

## SSC GD Constable 2023 Result

Lastly, you should be aware of the date of declaration of the results. However, there were no update regarding the release date of the SSC GD Constable exam 2023. However, if we are to go with the trends that SSC follows, we can expect the result in or around April 2023. Moreover, the candidates shortlisted in the Computer-Based Examination will appear for the PET/PST exam. Subsequently, the final result will be announced in the month of June or July 2023.
