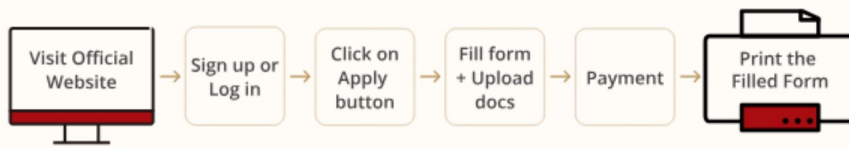

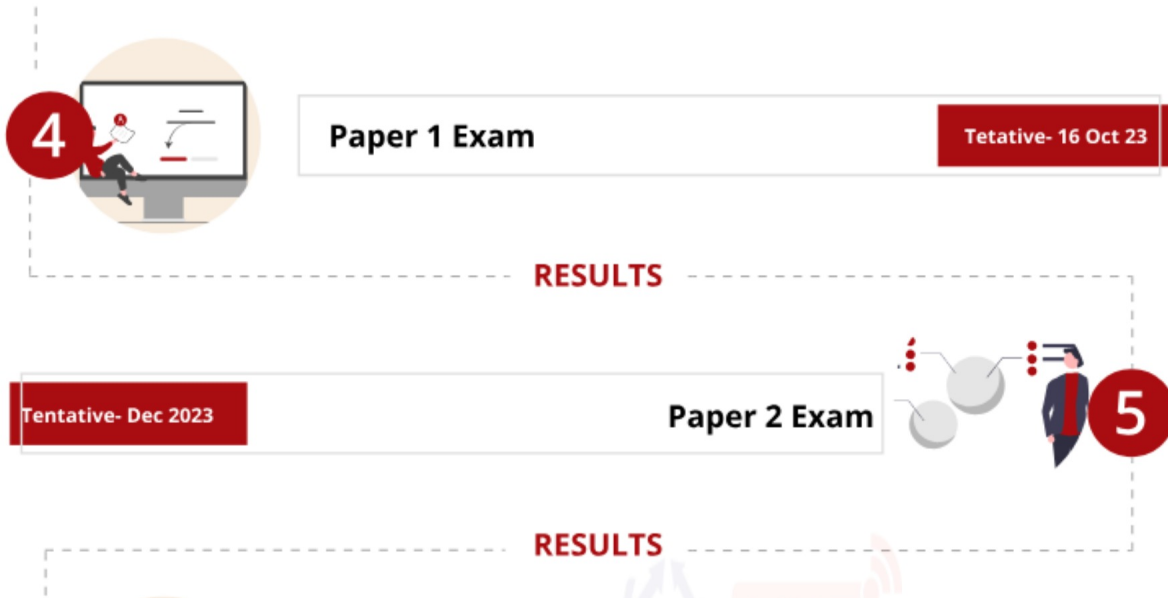

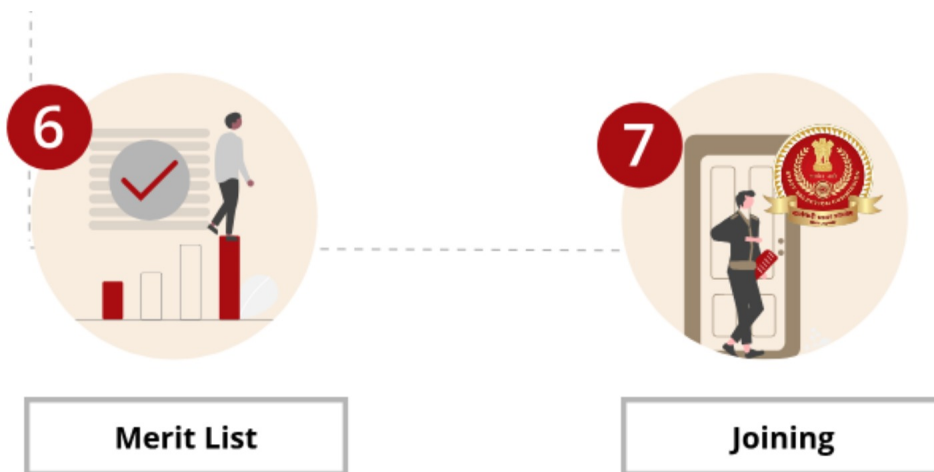

SSC JHT 2023 Eligibility Criteria

If we ask you, what comes to your mind first when you hear that an official notification of an exam has been released? For most of you, the answer might be its Eligibility Criteria. So, here we are to answer all your doubts pertaining to the eligibility criteria as mentioned in the SSC JHT Notification 2023. Following are the three eligibility criterias mentioned in the SSC JHT Notification 2023.

- **Nationality/Citizenship:** A candidate must be either a citizen of India or a subject of Nepal or a subject of Bhutan or a Tibetan refugee who came over to India before the 1st January 1962 with the intention of permanently settling in India.
- **Age limit (as on 01.08.2023):** The age limit is 18 to 30 years as of 01-08-2023, meaning candidates born not before 02-08-1993 and not later than 01-08-2005 are eligible to apply.
- **Educational qualifications (as on 01.08.2023):** Candidates holding a Master's degree in Hindi and possessing a Certificate/Diploma in Translation are eligible for this post.

SSC JHT 2023 Posts and Salary

The post of SSC JHT will provide you with a secured annual income. According to the official SSC JHT Notification 2023, the Staff Selection Commission will hold an open competitive examination for recruitment of Group 'B' Non-Gazetted posts of Junior Hindi Translator, Junior Translator and Senior Hindi Translator for various Ministries/ Departments/ Organizations in the Government of India. The details of various posts are as under-

1. Junior Translator in Central Secretariat Official Language Service (CSOLS) **Level-6 (Rs.35400- 112400)**
2. Junior Translator in Armed Forces Headquarters (AFHQ) **Level-6 (Rs.35400- 112400)**
3. Junior Translator/ officer in various Central Government Ministries/Departments/Offices **Level 6 (Rs.35400- 112400)**
4. Senior Hindi translator in various Central Government Ministries/Departments/Offices **Level-7 (Rs.44900-142400)**

Now that you have known all the lucrative aspects of this job, how about we take you on a tour of the exam pattern? The recruitment exam of Junior Hindi Translator consists of two papers. One of which is a Computer Based Test while the other one is a Descriptive Test. Moreover, the weightage of both the Papers is same. But the pattern is slightly different. Let's decode the pattern in bullet points to make it easy to understand!

Paper I - Objective type (MCQ questions)

- Total No. of questions: 200
- Maximum marks: 200
 - General Hindi: 100 questions and 100 marks
 - General English: 100 questions and 100 marks
- Negative marking: 0.25
- Time duration: 2 hours

Candidates who pass Paper I will be eligible for Paper II which is a subjective/descriptive paper and requires a pen and paper.

Paper II – Subjective type

- **Translation and Essay**
 - Maximum Marks: 200
 - Time Duration: 2 hours

SSC JHT 2023 Syllabus

You must have a good comprehension of the subjects for which you need to study after learning about the exam pattern. As the syllabus directs your study efforts, resource choices, and time management, resulting to a more organized and strategic preparation process, it is now crucial to understand it in detail. The paper wise syllabus for SSC JHT is as follows:

- **SSC JHT Paper 1 syllabus** covers general Hindi, basic grammar, Hindi synonyms, Hindi paragraphs, Hindi proverbs, Hindi phrases, comprehension, knowledge of Hindi, general English, fill in the blanks, error correction, articles, verbs, prepositions, spelling test, vocabulary, phrases and idioms, sentence correction, antonyms,
- **SSC JHT Paper 2 syllabus** will have 4 descriptive questions. It includes Hindi to English translation, English to Hindi translation, English essay writing, and Hindi essay writing.

SSC JHT 2023 Marking Scheme

SSC JHT Notification 2023 - Recruitment for 307 Govt Jobs

As we are aware that the SSC JHT exam consists of two papers, out of which Paper 1 is a multiple choice Computer Based Test. Whereas, Paper 2 is a Descriptive one. Thus, Paper 1 consists of 200 questions for 1 mark each. However, for every wrong answer, there is a penalty of 0.25 marks i.e., 1 mark for 4 errors. On the other hand, Paper 2 has no such negative marking.

Now that you are in alignment with the marking scheme, lets know in detail about how the marks normalisation works in SSC JHT examination.

SSC JHT 2023 Marks Normalisation

Let's start by defining what normalisation of marks actually is. It's a statistical method that accounts for any variations in the level of difficulty of the question papers across various shifts of the same exam. Due to the possibility of varying question complexity between shifts, direct score comparison may not be fair. By bringing the scores into parity, normalisation overcomes this issue and enables a more accurate evaluation of applicants.

As a result, the formula was published by the [Staff Selection Commission in Notice No. 1-1/2018-P&P-I on February 7, 2019](#), and has been used ever then.

The staff selection commission released the official notification for SSC JHT exam 2023 on 22nd August 2023. Further, the application link will close after 20 days of the release date i.e 12th September 2023. Make sure you fill all necessary details correctly to avoid hustle later. SSC JHT 2023 Application Fee

Although there is a Rs. 100 application fee for the SSC JHT exam but not everyone is required to pay it. Some people are excluded from having to pay the charge and those are:

- Women candidates
- ST/SC/OBC candidates
- PwD candidates
- Ex servicemen

The payment can be made online via BHIM UPI, Net Banking etc. or in offline mode through cash in SBI Branches by generating challan.

SSC JHT How to apply online: Step by Step Approach

1. If you're a first-time candidate, you'll need to register at the official website of SSC.
2. There are two parts to the application form: a one-time registration and an online application form. To register for the exam, go to the official website and click on 'Register Now'.
3. Then, enter your basic details, extra info, and contact info. Upload your passport-size photo and signature, and submit the registration form.
4. Once you complete that step, you'll need to select your center and complete the remaining details, such as your educational background, top qualifications, etc. Some of the information on the application form will be pre-filled based on the registration form.
5. After that, you need to pick your center and fill out the rest of the details, like your educational background and your top qualification.
6. Finally, you need to preview and check the info on the application form, pay the fees, and submit the application. Then you can print out the application and keep it for future reference.

As per the official notification of 2023, the Staff Selection Commission (SSC) tends to release the admit card 10 to 15 days prior to the exam dates. Since Paper 1 of the SSC JHT examination is scheduled for October, we can anticipate the release of admit cards to occur around the beginning of the same month or the last week of September 2023.

Furthermore, while filling out the online Application Form (ANS), candidates need to indicate the Examination Center(s) for which they intend to appear. Furthermore, the official SSC JHT notification 2023 will provide a detailed information regarding the Examination Centers and the respective Regional Offices that manage them.
