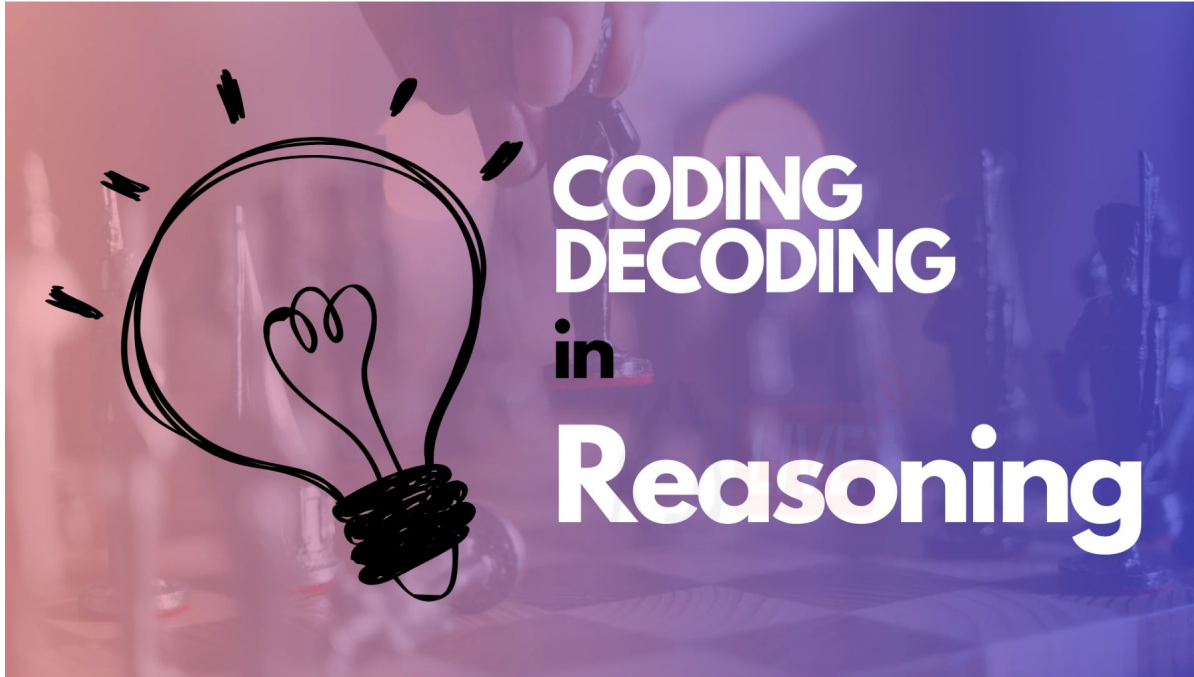

Direction (3 - 5): Study the following information and answer the given questions.

In alphabetical series, each consonant is assigned a different number from 1-7 (for ex- B is coded as 1, C-2..... J-7) and again those numbers get repeated (for ex- K-1, L-2.....so on).

Besides the above information, the following operations are to be applied for coding the words given in the questions below.

Also, each letter of the given questions will be coded as per the given conditions:

- I. Number immediately preceded by a vowel will be coded as '#'.
- II. Number immediately followed by a vowel will be coded as '&'.
- III. Vowels appearing before 'M' in the Alphabetical series will be coded as '31'.
- IV. Vowels appearing after 'M' in the alphabetical series will be coded as '14'.

For example, NORMAL is coded as '&14#&31#'. **[IBPS Clerk Mains 2020]**

Solutions of Coding Previous Year Questions of SSC

Q:1 (4) Letters of the word are arranged in the ascending order of the English Alphabetical series.

'BEHOLD' is written as 'BDEHLO'

BEHOLD = BDEHLO

'INDEED' is written as 'DDEEIN'

INDEED = DDEEIN

Similarly; Code for the word COURSE:

COURSE = CEORSU

Q:2 (2) EXTREME is written as VCGIVNV

Opposite of E = V, Opposite of X = C, Opposite of T = G, Opposite of R = I, Opposite of E = V, Opposite of M = N, Opposite of E = V

Similarly, Code for the word INITIAL

Opposite of I = R, Opposite of N = M, Opposite of I = R, Opposite of T = G, Opposite of I = R, Opposite of A = Z, Opposite of L = O

Q:3 (3) FRUCTUS is coded as 108

FRUCTUS = 6 + 18 + 21 + 3 + 20 + 21 + 19 = 108

SPRINTER is coded as 119

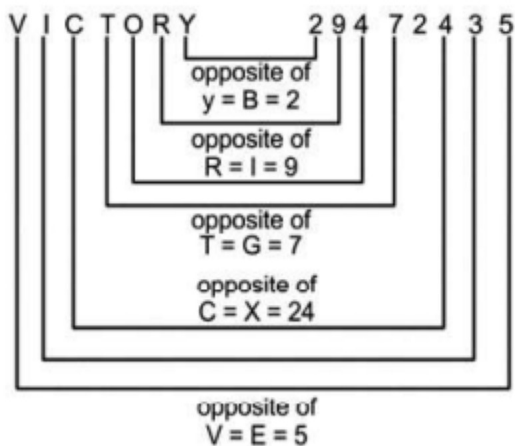
SPRINTER = 19 + 16 + 18 + 9 + 14 + 20 + 5 + 18 = 119

Similarly; Code for the word MASCULINE:

MASCULINE = 13 + 1 + 19 + 3 + 21 + 12 + 9 + 14 + 5 = 97

Q:4 (1) VICTORY is coded as 29472435

Consonants are coded for their opposite alphabet place values and vowels are coded as position number vowel position as A = 1, E = 2, I = 3, O = 4, and U = 5.

Solutions of Coding Memory Based Questions of Bank

Q:1 (1) The codes for different elements/words are:

revenue **exceeds** expectation → rz **en** ds
 money **ahead** **instruments** → **ad** mg **is**
other transaction **ahead** → **tn** **ad** or
instruments **exceeds** **other** → **en** **is** **tn**

Therefore, the correct answer is tn mg ki.

Q:2 (3) The codes for different elements/words are:

they **all** **are** **playing** → **mz** **rs** **yh** **yg**
 where **are** **they** going → **yh** rh gg **rs**
 you **are** not **playing** → **yg** oy tn **rs**

Hence, the correct answer is they are not playing.

(Q:3 – Q:5) Logic- The different number codes for all the consonants as per the given

B-1, C-2, D-3, F-4, G-5, H-6, J-7
 K-1, L-2, M-3, N-4, P-5, Q-6, R-7
 S-1, T-2, V-3, W-4, X-5, Y-6, Z-7

Step 1: The consonants of the word 'NORMAL' are to be coded as the number allotted to the consonant:

N O R M A L
 4 O 7 3 A 2

Step 2: The numbers immediately preceded and followed by the vowels are to be coded as per the given conditions; So, the code for consonant for the word 'NORMAL' is coded as '4073A2', numbers 4 and 7 are immediately preceded and followed by 'O' so, '4' is coded as '&' and '7' is coded as '#'.
 Similarly, '3' and '2' is immediately preceded and followed respectively by 'A' so, '3' is coded as '&' and '2' is coded as '#'.
