Eight friends namely P, Q, R, S, T, U, V, and W are sitting around a rectangular table facing each other such that two persons each sit at the length and two persons each sit at the breadth of the table but not necessarily in the same order. All of them are facing inside.

Q sits fourth to the right of P who sits at the length of the table. Two persons sit between U and Q. U doesn't sit at the breadth of the table and also doesn't sit to the immediate left of P. S is an immediate neighbor of Q and faces W. V sits third to the left of T, who doesn't sit near S.

**Q:1** Who faces T?

**Directions (6 - 10):** Read the given information carefully and answer the following questions.

10 people A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, and J are seated on a Rectangular table. Three people sit on each longer side and two person sit on each shorter side. Some of them are facing inside and some of them are facing outside. Not more than two people facing the same direction sit near each other. No two persons sit adjacent to each other according to the English alphabet (i.e. B does not sit adjacent to A and C and so on).

A who sits on the longer side faces outside and sits second to the left of G who sits on the shorter side. J who is immediate left of A sits five places away from C who faces inside. C doesn't sit second to the right of G. I who sits on the longer side is third to the left of J who sits second to the right of E who faces inside. D sits immediate left of I who sits third to the left of H. The direction of B and D is opposite to H.

**Q:6** How many people sit between G and H?

1. Same as the number of people sit between A and D

2. Same as the number of people sit between F and J

3. Same as the number of people sit between C and I



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4. Same as the number of people sit between B and E
5. Same as the number of people sit between I and E

## Solutions of Rectangular arrangement Questions

**(Q:1 - Q:5):** 1) Q sits fourth to the right of P who sits at the length of the table.

2) Two persons sit between U and Q.

3) U doesn't sit at the breadth of the table and also doesn't sit to the immediate left of P.

(This means that U is sitting to the immediate right of P at the length of the table.)



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4) S is an immediate neighbor of Q and faces W.

5) V sits third to the left of T, who doesn't sit near S. (This means that V is sitting immediate left of S and T is sitting immediate right of Q.)

(By using elimination we can conclude that R is sitting immediately to the right of W.)

Now we have our final arrangement:



**Q:1** The correct answer is **Option 5** i.e. **P**

Clearly, P faces T.

Hence, the correct answer is **P**.

**Q:2** The correct answer is **Option 4** i.e. **S**

Clearly, S sits immediately right of V.

Hence the correct answer is **S**.

**Q:3** The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. **Two**

Clearly, Two persons sit between R and Q when counted from the left of R.

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Hence the correct answer is **Two**.

**Q:4** The correct answer is **Option 1** i.e. **V**

Clearly, R faces V.

Hence, the correct answer is **V**.

**Q:5** The correct answer is **Option 2** i.e. **S**

Clearly, S sits third to the left of W.

Hence the correct answer is **S**.

**(Q:6 - Q:10):** 1. A who sits on the longer side faces outside and sits second to the left of G who sits on the shorter side.  
(Here, we have 3 cases i.e. Case 1, Case 2, and Case 3)

2. J who is immediately left of A sits five places away from C who faces inside.

3. C doesn't sit second to the right of G.

Now, we can eliminate Case 1 and Case 3. (because in Case 1 and Case 3, C sits second to the right of G)

4. I who sits on the longer side is third to the left of J who sits second to the right of E who faces inside. (i.e. E sits immediately right of A and I sits second to the left of C and J faces outside)

5. D sits immediately left of I who sits third to the left of H. (i.e. D doesn't sit adjacent to C, then D sits immediate right of G, and H sits immediate right of C and I faces inside)

(B doesn't sit adjacent to C then B sits immediately right of H so the remaining person F sits between C and I and faces outside because not more than two people facing the same direction sit near each other)

6. The direction of B and D is opposite to H. (i.e. B and D faces outside)

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This is our final arrangement.

**Q:6** The correct answer is **Option 5** i.e. **Same as the number of people sit between I and E**

Clearly, Same as the number of people sitting between I and E i.e. 4 people sitting between G and H.

Hence, the correct answer is '**Same as the number of people sit between I and E**'.

**Q:7** The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. **The one who sits immediately left of E**

Clearly, C sits second to the right of I, similarly, B sits second to the right of A. So, B is related to A.

Hence, the correct answer is '**The one who sits immediately left of E**'.

**Q:8** The correct answer is **Option 4** i.e. **The one who sits immediate left of C**

Except for the one who sits immediately left of C i.e. F, all are facing inside.

Hence, the correct answer is '**The one who sits immediately left of C**'.

**Q:9** The correct answer is **Option 1** i.e. **5**

Clearly, 5 people are facing outside.

Hence, the correct answer is '**5**'.

**Q:10** The correct answer is **Option 1** i.e. **The one who sits immediately right of F**

Clearly, The one who sits immediately right of F i.e. I sits second to the right of G.

Hence, the correct answer is '**The one who sits immediately right of F**'.
