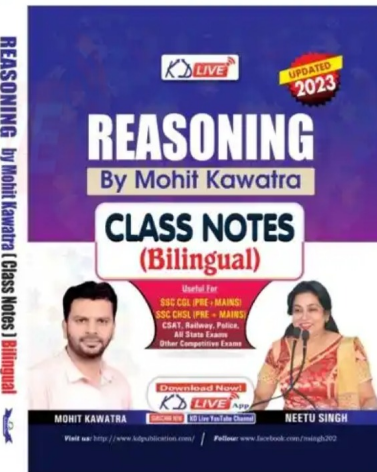
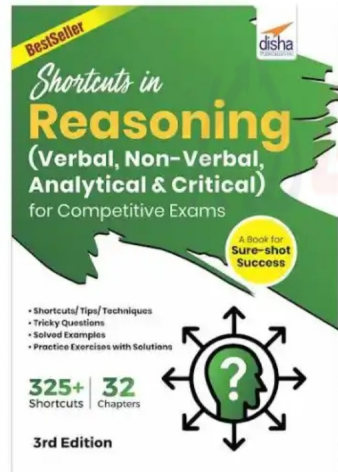
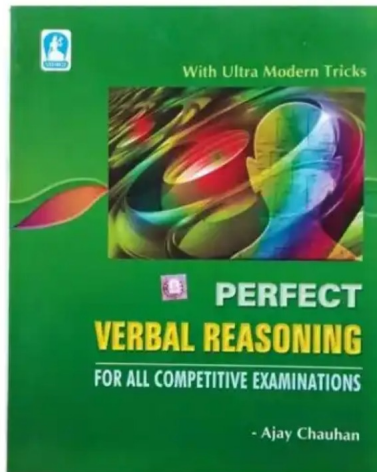
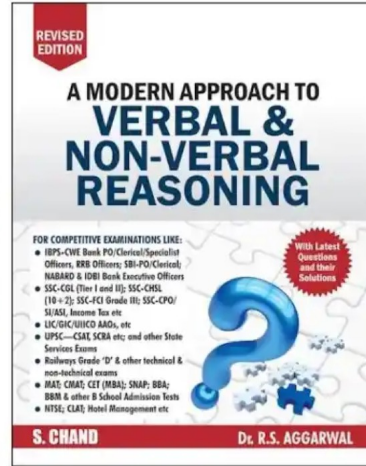
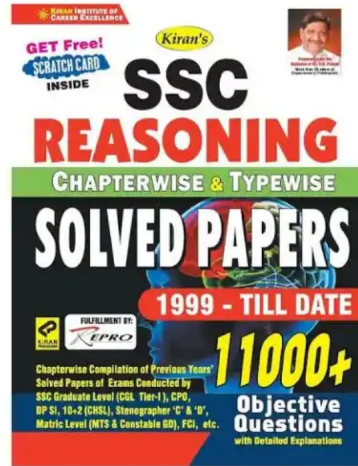
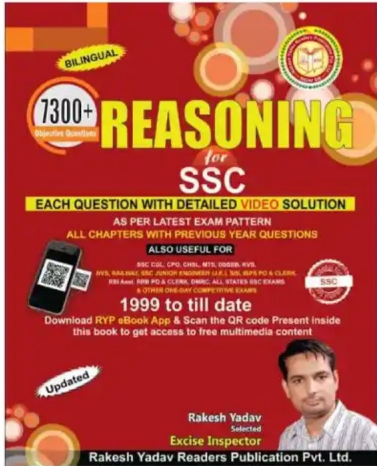
Based on the table, it's clear that in Tier 2 Figure based questions carry the highest weight in the SSC CGL in Logical Reasoning.
