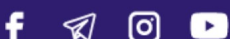

The Computer Based Examination (CBE) is structured as follows:

- Session 1: 40 questions, each worth 3 marks, with a total duration of 45 minutes.
- Session 2: 50 questions, also worth 3 marks each, with a 45 minute time limit.
- There is no negative marking in Session 1, but in Session 2, 1 mark is deducted for each incorrect answer.
- Note that there is no penalty for leaving a question unanswered.
- Candidates eligible for a scribe are given 60 minutes per session instead of the standard 45 minutes.

The Physical Standard Test (PST) serves as a qualification criterion, setting specific requirements for the following:

- Height
- Chest
- Weight

These standards vary for males and females. The table below details the exact measurements for height, chest, and weight necessary for the PST.

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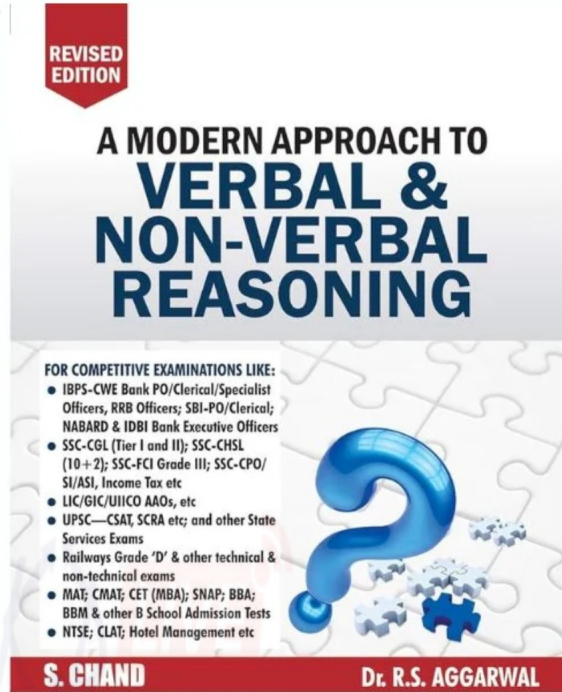
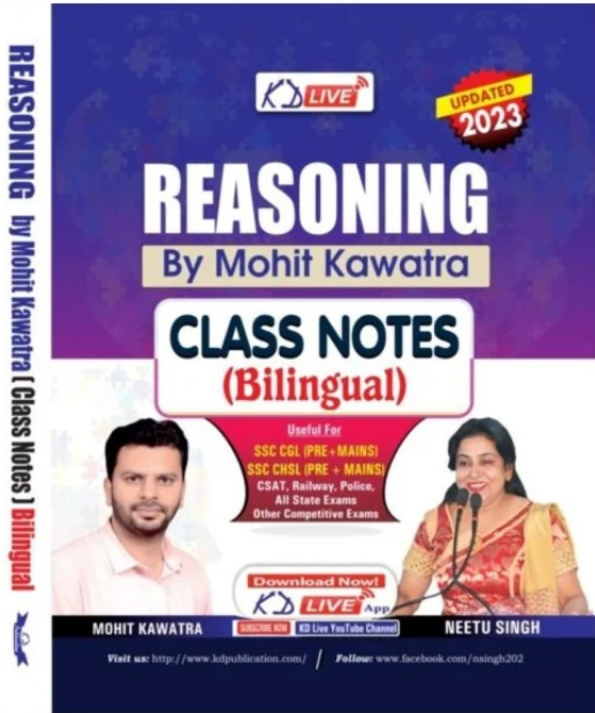
