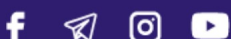

- Moreover, each subject consists of 25 questions, each worth 2 marks.
- Furthermore, there are a total of 100 questions, with a maximum score of 200 achievable in SSC CHSL Tier I.
- You should be mindful that there is a negative marking of 0.50 marks for each incorrect answer in SSC CHSL Tier I exam. Thus, it is advisable to consider this while responding to the questions.
- Tier II will be conducted in two sessions: Session I and Session II on the same day.
- Session I will include conducting Section I, Section II, and Module I of Section III. Session II will involve conducting Module II of Section III.

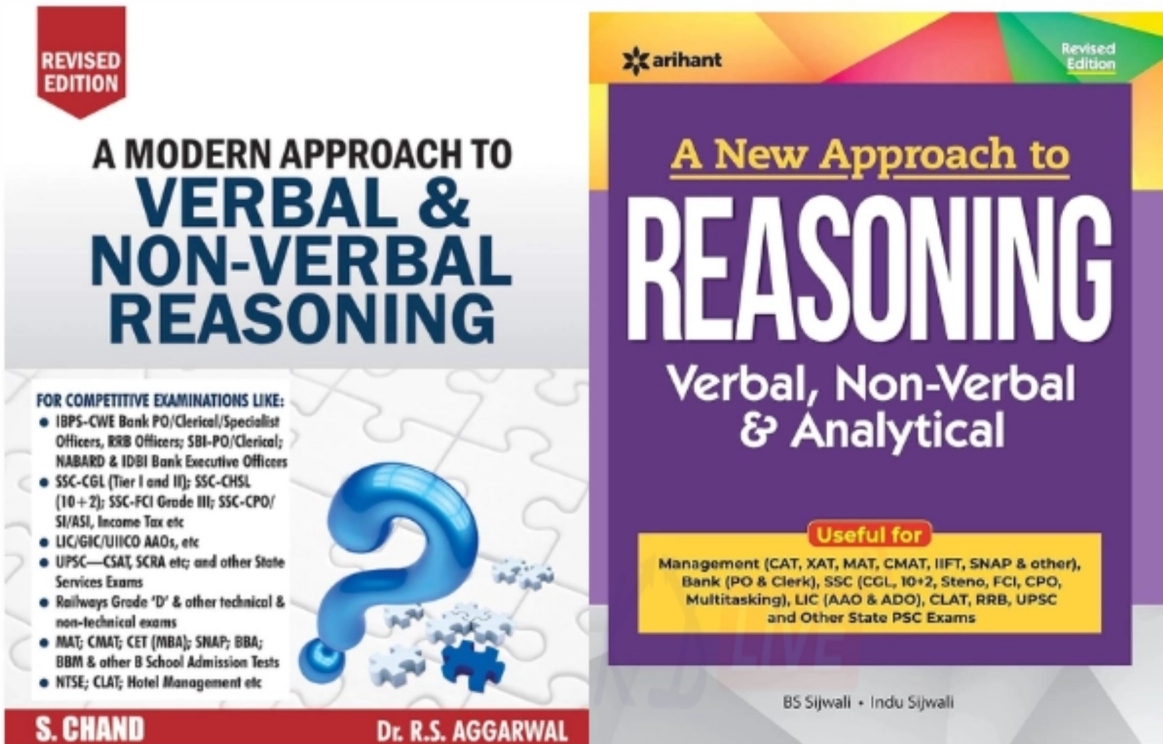
