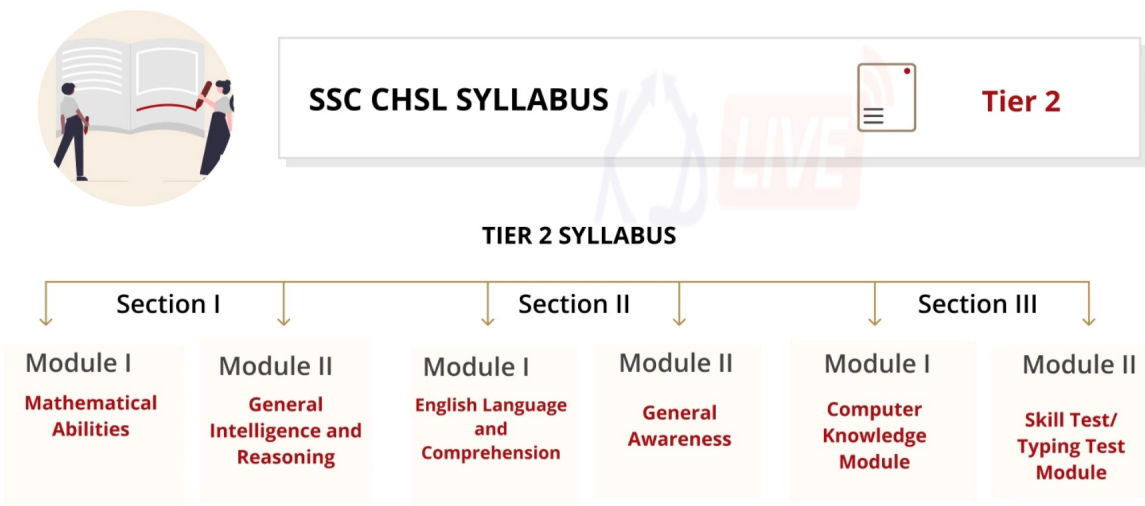

Session II will cover Module II of Section III. It is mandatory for candidates to qualify in all sections of Tier II. Below, we have listed the subjects covered in the CHSL Tier 2 Syllabus.

## CHSL Tier 2 Syllabus - Topic Wise Weightage

Knowing which topics carry more weight will allow you to allocate your study time more efficiently. You can prioritize topics that are likely to appear more frequently or carry higher marks. Overall, understanding topic-wise weightage empowers you to study smarter, enhance your readiness for exams, and increase your chances of achieving higher scores. Therefore, let us take a look at the SSC CHSL Tier 2 topic wise weightages.

It is evident from the above table that Series holds the maximum weightage, which is then followed Analogies and Coding Decoding.

It can be observed that Geometry and DI hold the maximum weightage as compared to other topics in Quantitative Aptitude.

Accordingly, we can see that Reading Comprehension holds the maximum weightage among the provided topics in Tier 2.

The SSC CHSL Computer Based examination is divided into two tiers: Tier 1 and Tier 2. Tier 1 consists of 100 Objective Type, Multiple Choice Questions, with a maximum score of 200 marks. There is a penalty of 0.50 marks for each incorrect answer, making accuracy essential for maximizing your score.

## CHSL Tier 2 Syllabus - Subject Wise Topics Weightage

Tier 2 of the SSC CHSL exam will be conducted in two sessions on the same day. Session I will include Section I, Section II, and Module I of Section III, while Session II will cover Module II of Section III. Except for Module II of Section III, Tier 2 will feature Objective Type, Multiple Choice Questions. The questions will be available in English, Hindi, and any other language you selected during the application process.

## CHSL Marks Normalization

First, let's clarify what is meant by "

[marks normalization](#)

." A statistical method called "marks normalization" is used to account for changes in question paper difficulty between exam shifts. Because of these variations in question complexity, it would be unfair to compare scores directly between shifts. By ensuring that scores are uniform, normalization helps to close this gap and enables a more accurate evaluation of candidates.

To address this issue, SSC has released a formula, as outlined in

[Notice No.1-1/2018-P&P-I dated 07-02-2019](#)

. These standardized scores will be used to determine the cut-off marks, which will subsequently contribute to the compilation of the merit list.
